Cranial Sacral Basics

This introductory course is based on the work of William G Sutherland, DO and other early osteopaths. We will cover the history, theory and anatomy of the cranial sacral system. This hands-on workshop will focus on palpation of anatomy and how to integrate cranial work into your present practice. *This class is a great foundational and review course for any cranial sacral training.*

- Palpate the Primary Respiratory Mechanism
- Identify Cranial anatomy
- Identify and palpate the anatomy of the sacrum
- Identify and palpate cranial sacral restrictions
- Identify contraindications to cranial sacral therapy
- Begin to integrate cranial sacral theory into practice
