Late Payments

Per state law, a penalty of 1.5% will be added to all past due payments. The **penalty increases 1.5%** every 30 days until taxes are paid. Taxes received by mail with a postmark after the due date are considered late and will be assessed a penalty.



DROP YOUR TAXES

Use our convenient 24hr. DropBox, located at 189 E. Court Street, just west of the main entrance on Court St. The DropBox is available from May 1st through September 4th.

TAX BILL TERMINOLOGY

Fair Cash Value - The amount for which a property can be sold in the due course of business and trade, not under duress, between a willing buyer and a willing seller.

Assessed Value - The value placed on a property for tax purposes and the basis for determining what portion of the overall tax burden each property owner will bear.

Equalized Assessed Value (EAV) - The result of applying the state equalization factor to the assessed value of a parcel of property. Tax bills are calculated by multiplying the EAV (after any deductions for homesteads) by the tax rate.

- Walk-in & Pay at the Treasurer's Office, 189 E. Court Street, Kankakee.
- Mail a check all it costs is a stamp and an envelope. Please include your coupon. For a receipt, please include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
- Pay at a local bank you may pay at more than 30 bank and credit union locations. You will need to present your tax bill coupon to pay at a participating bank. Use the drive-up for a quick transaction.
- Online with Credit Card / eCheck visit kankakeecountytreasurer.com to pay Real Estate taxes by credit card or eCheck. Please be aware there is a convenience fee of \$1.00 for eCheck and 2.3% for credit card. Visa debit cards incur a \$3.95 fee. These fees are charged by the bank processor and not our county.

Reminders

- The online payment system will inform you if a mortgage company has or plans to pay your taxes.
- When mailing your payment, please separate the appropriate coupon and include with your payment.
- There is \$5 Duplicate Bill Fee when tax stub is not included with payment.
