Landfill Expenses and Transfers: February YTD 2024 expenses (\$44,138.34)/transfers (\$45,000) total \$89,138.24 compared to February YTD 2025 expenses (\$48,593.16)/transfers (\$154,739.69) total \$203,692.85.
