### **Meeting Minutes**

#### **April 2, 2026, Meeting – 6:00 pm MDT Mueller Center**

The Custer-Fall River Regional Waste Management District Board meeting was called to order at 6:01 pm on Thursday, April 2, 2026, at the Mueller Center, Hot Springs, SD by Chairman Mike Linde.

Members Present: Mike Linde, Chairman, Custer County; Les Cope, Vice Chairman, Fall River County; Peg Ryan, Secretary/Treasurer, Custer; Ray Hussey, Buffalo Gap; Rheta Reagan, Edgemont; Dean Weekley, Fairburn; Craig Romey, Hot Springs; and Vince Logue, Oelrichs. Members Absent: Dee Anderson, Pringle. Others Present: Starla Russell, Deputy Secretary/Treasurer.

All motions approved unanimously unless otherwise noted.

No conflicts of interest were noted.

Motion by Reagan, second by Ryan to approve the April 2, 2026, agenda.

Motion by Reagan, second by Ryan to approve the January 8, 2026, meeting minutes.

The Treasurer's Report was presented. Motion by Reagan, second by Romey to approve the Treasurer's Report, with a correction to the Transfer to FI Money Market from \$20,000 to \$40,000.

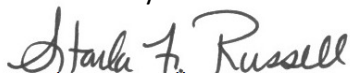
Kerry Barker of Barker Concrete and Construction was not in attendance to provide a report. Estimates received by FMG for the replacement/repair of the high fence/netting were discussed, including two separate costs: one for the materials from Coastal Netting Systems for \$58,427.25 and one for the labor and equipment for installation from Going for Broke LLC, for \$49,998.96. FMG conducted an additional review and estimates each be less than \$50,000. Motion by Reagan, second by Hussey to approve the two separate purchases for the materials from Coastal Netting Systems and the labor and equipment for installation from Going for Broke LLC, pending the costs are less than \$50,000 each. The Concrete Crushing Project and end-Product Use Assessment agenda item was not discussed.

Jason Hinds of FMG was not in attendance to provide a report. The Site Characterization for Cell III Closure/New Cell Opening and Water Sampling, as well as the Grant for Cell III Closure/New Cell Opening agenda items were not discussed. It was reported the 2025 Annual Water Testing Report was submitted to DANR, as was the 2025 Financial Assurance Fund Balance.

The Fall River County Herald-Star has requested the District seek another web administrator for the District's website. A proposal to build/transfer the website to a new platform for a one-time cost of \$500 and \$19.95 monthly hosting fee was received by Life Light Creative, LLC. After the website has been transferred, the Deputy Secretary will be trained to make necessary updates. Motion by Reagan, second by Hussey to accept the proposal from Life Light Creative, LLC.

Motion by Romey, second by Logue to adjourn. Meeting adjourned at 6:30 pm.
