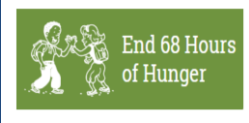
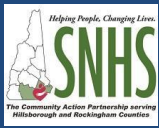




Food Resources in Nashua During Covid-19 Quarantine
