To sustain the momentum of showcasing businesses, Pyramid CDC revived its retail development model, The Op!, opening a 13,000 square foot Vendor Pop-up Shop at 222 Neilston Street in the Columbus Warehouse District for the Holiday Season. From November to December 2023, businesses gained training in the following areas:

- Customer Service
- Sales Techniques
- Inventory Management
- Merchandising
- Operational Aspects of the Retail

Over 20 Small Business Retail Vendors and 20 Entrepreneurial Events from various cultures were featured, servicing over 1,000 customers.



The Op! Marketplace – Vendor Events

The Op! Marketplace drew in over 20 Small Business Retail Vendors and 20 Entrepreneurial Events for all ages and cultures. The Op!
