

## Welcome to the 2022-23 Yorba Linda High School Men's Basketball Program!

We are excited your son has shown interest in the YLHS Men's Basketball Program by attending our summer camp. We hope he enjoyed the experience and training over the first month of summer. We would like to take this opportunity to briefly outline our mission and provide information regarding upcoming tryouts, team selections, our booster organization, and athlete support.

YLHS Men's Basketball is focused on preparing our athletes to compete at the highest level. Athletes will try out during the first TWO WEEKS of school for a limited number of positions on THREE YLHS teams: Freshmen, JV and Varsity. Previous year team placement DOES NOT ensure any player a position or team assignment for the upcoming season. The coaching staff has the final decision on all athlete placements. Tryout dates/times will be communicated to you when they become finalized. They will also be placed on our website <a href="https://www.ylhsmensbasketball.org">ylhsmensbasketball.org</a> when available.

Upon accepting a position on any team, athletes will receive a variety of gear, equipment, and training as a part of their team participation. With decreasing district and state funding for athletics and extracurricular activities, the vast majority of the financial responsibility for this lies within our booster organization. The YLHS Men's Basketball Booster Club is made up of parents and community supporters. We ALL work together to meet the ever-increasing financial demands of this dynamic sport through donations, fundraisers, and parental support. Our organization is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization with an all-volunteer board, committees, and general membership. We operate under established bylaws and a working budget.

Our goal is to provide athletes with quality coaching, equipment, uniforms, training, and a positive high school experience!
