A few thoughts on my trip to Rome. Sunday, May 18, 2025 Summary of the Major Superior Meeting On May 18, 2025, Pope Leo XIV shared with us the motto for his papacy, "In the One, we are one." He chose the name Leo, continuing the thinking of Pope Leo XIII, who wrote in his encyclical, Rerum Novarum, "It is the soul, which is made after the image

and likeness of God. There is here no difference between rich and

poor, master and servant, ruler and ruled. For the same is Lord over all." The workshop and Major Superior Meeting I attended in Rome with our Father General, Marco Tanghetti, his counsel, and provincials followed the same theme, one in Christ Jesus. Amazingly, our meetings ended two days before Pope Leo shared with us his motto.

We spent three days in a workshop on communication and leadership. We grew in our understanding of each other by listening to the person more than the ideas. Collaboration and honest communication through discussion of ideas and feelings create community while breaking down division and exclusion. In a session, we learned the steps to never be afraid to share with a brother or sister what you are honestly thinking and feeling. Problems result when we don't.

On the first Saturday, we visited local basilicas and places important to our Founder, Blessed Antonio Rosmini. The following week, we were blessed to pray and share our views on various topics to help us all grow in our calling to greater charity and fulfill the

As we look forward to the future, I was inspired by the thoughts and experiences of our brothers from different cultures. Our shared desire to follow Pope Leo's call, "In the One, we are one," was evident. We look forward to the future that is one filled with hope and inspiration for all members of our Institute and the Church we serve.

Please keep Fr. Tanghetti, our Superior General, and his curia in your prayers as they discern the Lord's way for us in the next few years. How exciting!

Peace be with all of you, good brother Knights.

It is an exciting time for all of us in the Catholic Church to welcome a new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIII. His 1st words to all of us were the words Jesus left us after his resurrection, "Peace be with you."

These were not only words but were filled with intent and meaning. Pope Leo has written a letter to President Putin to end the war with Ukraine. He calls us to move forward in faith without fear. We walk with him, "hand in hand with God and one another!"

He quoted St. Augustine addressing the 1.4 billion Catholics he now shepherds, 'With you, I am a Christian, and for you I am Bishop.' Stay close to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, a powerful Sacrament that allows us to confess our sins and receive God's absolution, and do not leave it for more than a month. Bring your family. Jesus asks so little of us for all that He suffered.

Last month, we discussed making sure your financial house is in order to minimize any tax liabilities that may arise from a larger estate. There are numerous financial options that can reduce taxes and provide more assets to your family or charity. This month, we'll address the need to review beneficiaries on life insurance, bank accounts, mutual funds, etc. Absolutely an item to review with your financial planner, lawyer, etc.

Beneficiary designations at death take precedence over the provisions of a will or trust. Regardless of the planning that has been done for distribution of the estate, if there is a designated beneficiary or beneficiaries, that person or persons will receive the asset at death. These beneficiary provisions have from time to time been challenged in court, but if the beneficiary and the contract were legal, turnovers are rare. Also, Florida is not a community property state, rather follows Equitable Distribution rules. What that means is that assets are not necessarily divided equally, especially in cases with an ex-spouse and current spouse. If you're divorced, and get remarried, who gets your inheritance? What if you've not been remarried?

Who do YOU want to get your inheritance? Example, maybe your ex-spouse has majority custody of your children and pays most of their expenses. Maybe it's your desire for them to have 100% of insurance money instead of "Equitable Distribution." If wills and beneficiaries do not have updated designations, you could be leaving your heirs lots of financial, legal, and family headaches when it's your turn to go home.

Updating beneficiaries on all financial documents is vitally important. This is especially true with Life Insurance contracts. It is also true for stocks, mutual funds, and other equity you may hold at time of death. And if you move to a Community Property state like California, Texas, Tennessee, and others, the rules of distribution can be altogether different.

Bottom line as always, consult with your financial planner, CPA or legal advisor, or Contact our Council's Ins. Agent. Make sure your documents are updated with just a little bit of time and paperwork. Hope that helps.

There is 4th Degree Assembly Regalia, which is purchased, again at a nominal cost, paid for by the advancing Knight.




PRAY FOR OUR BROTHERS IN NEED


