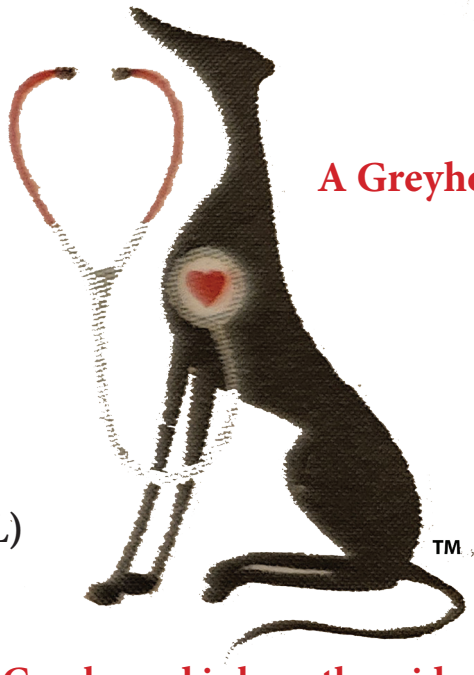


Greyhound Blood Card

Normal lab results in Greyhounds are not the same as other breeds

Normal	Greyhounds	Other Breeds
HCT/PCV	50% - 70%	42% - 62%
WBC	3.5-6.9	5.8-20.3
Platelets	110-205	173-497
Total Protein	4.8-6.3	5.1-7.1
Globulin	1.7-3.0	2.2-3.9
Creatinine	1.0-1.7	0.6-1.6
Total T4 (nMol/L)	8-20	20-33



A Greyhound with HCT/PCV <50% is anemic!

If you think your Greyhound is hypothyroid, please have your vet check the TSH.

Important Medication Dossages for Greyhounds

For Bleeding

Aminocaproic Acid (Amicar®) dose: 500-1,000 mg 3 times a day

For Thrombosis or Strokes:

Aspirin dose: ½ - 1 Cardio Aspirin (81mg) once a day
