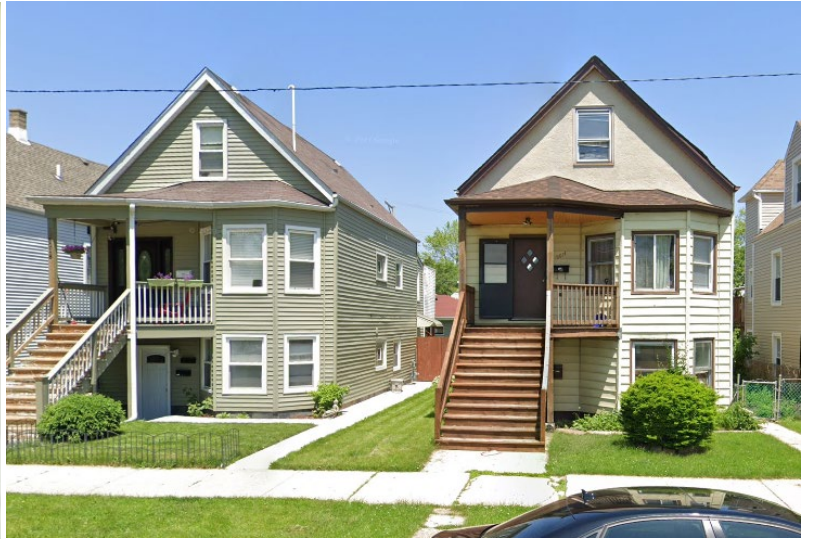

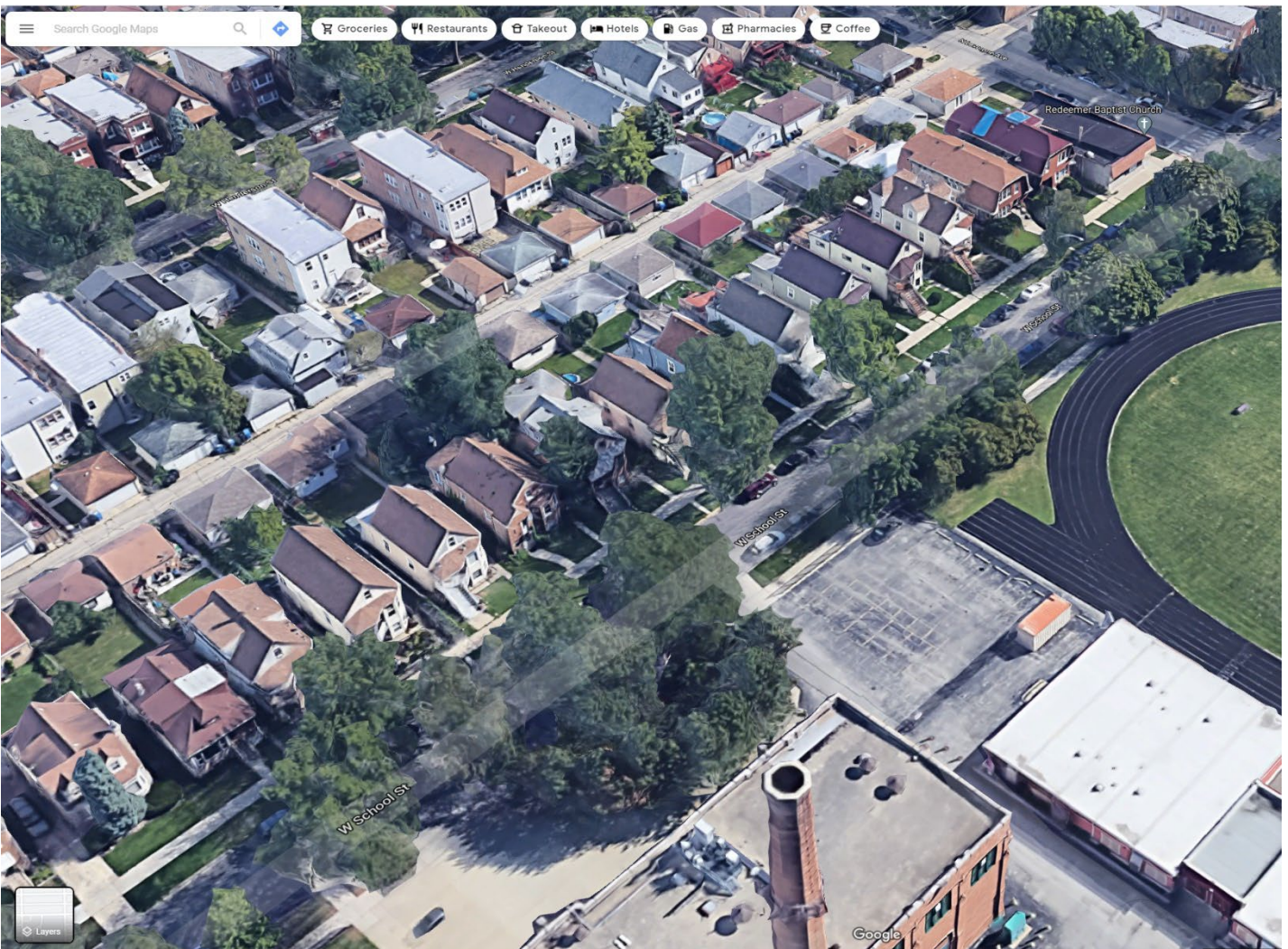


Figure 1 Same view in 2019

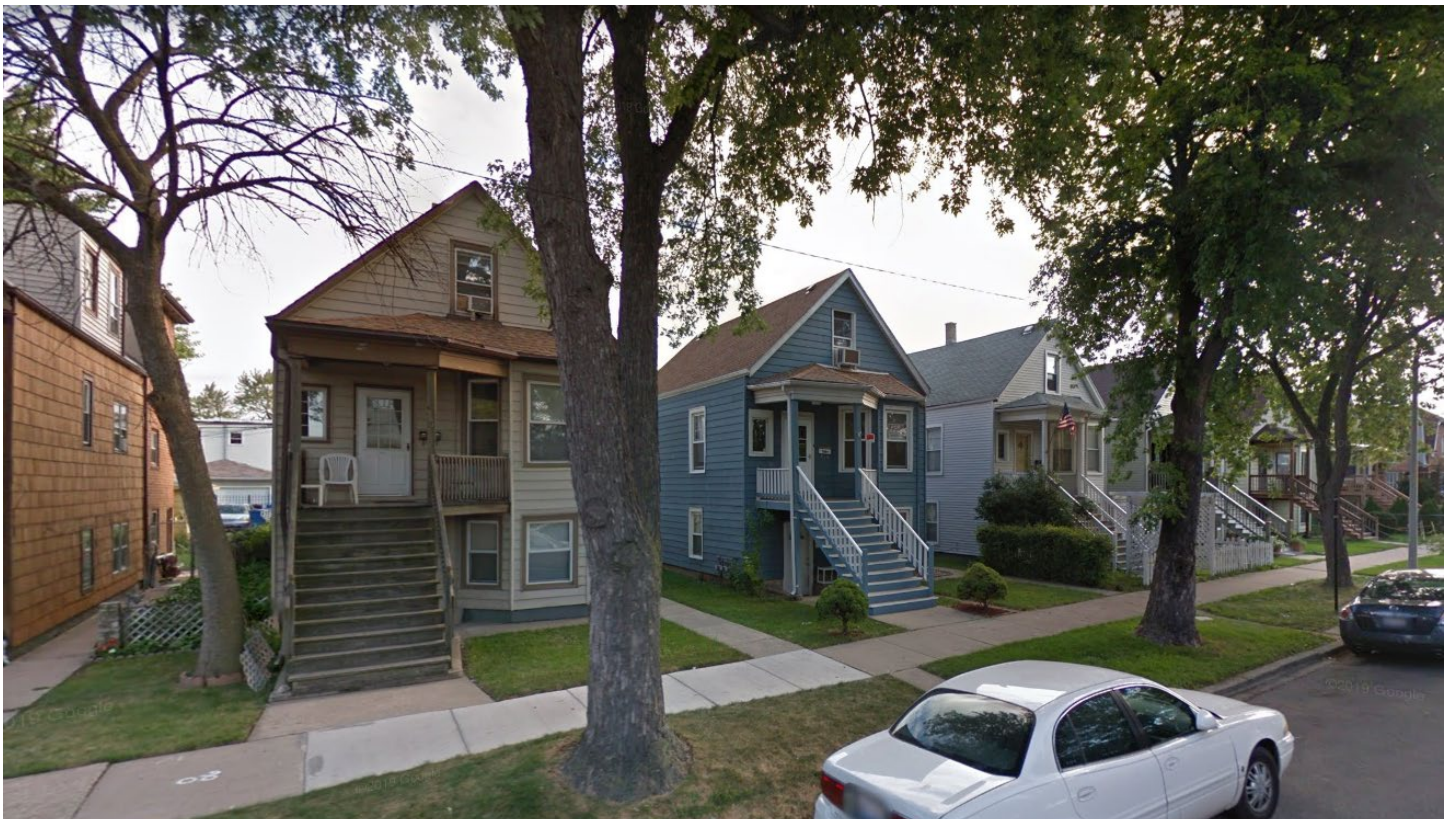

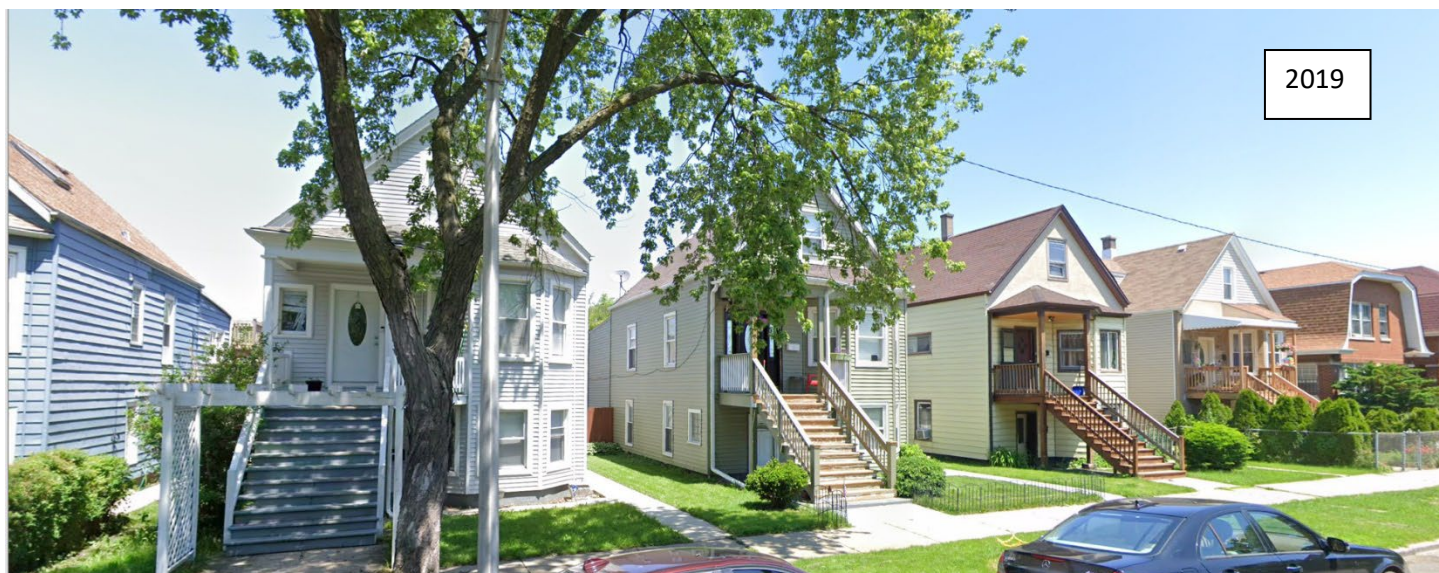

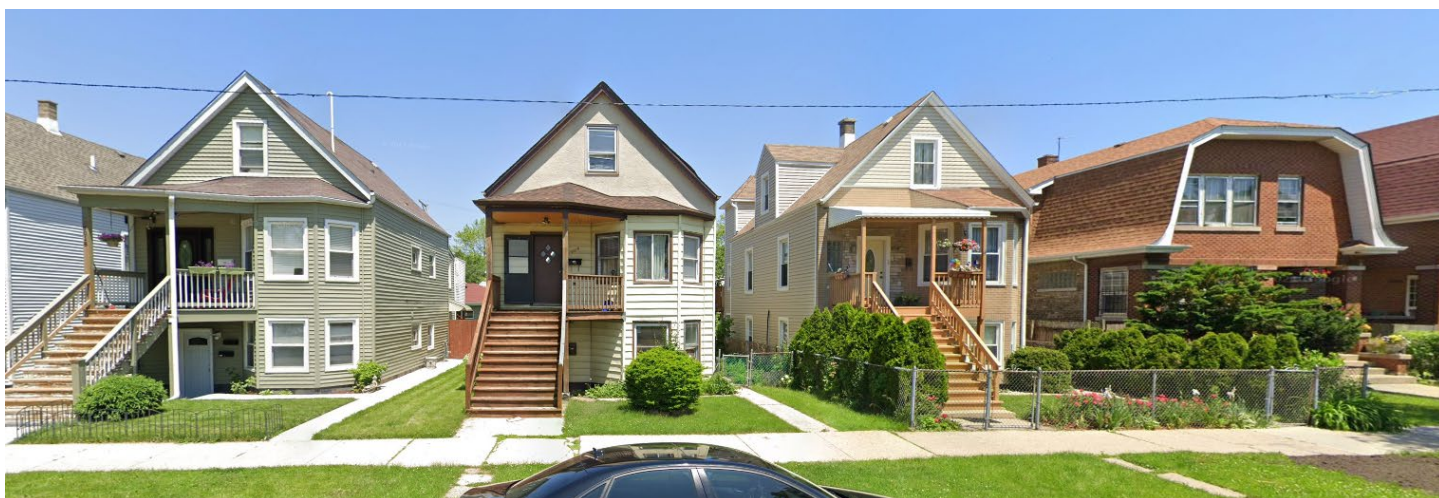

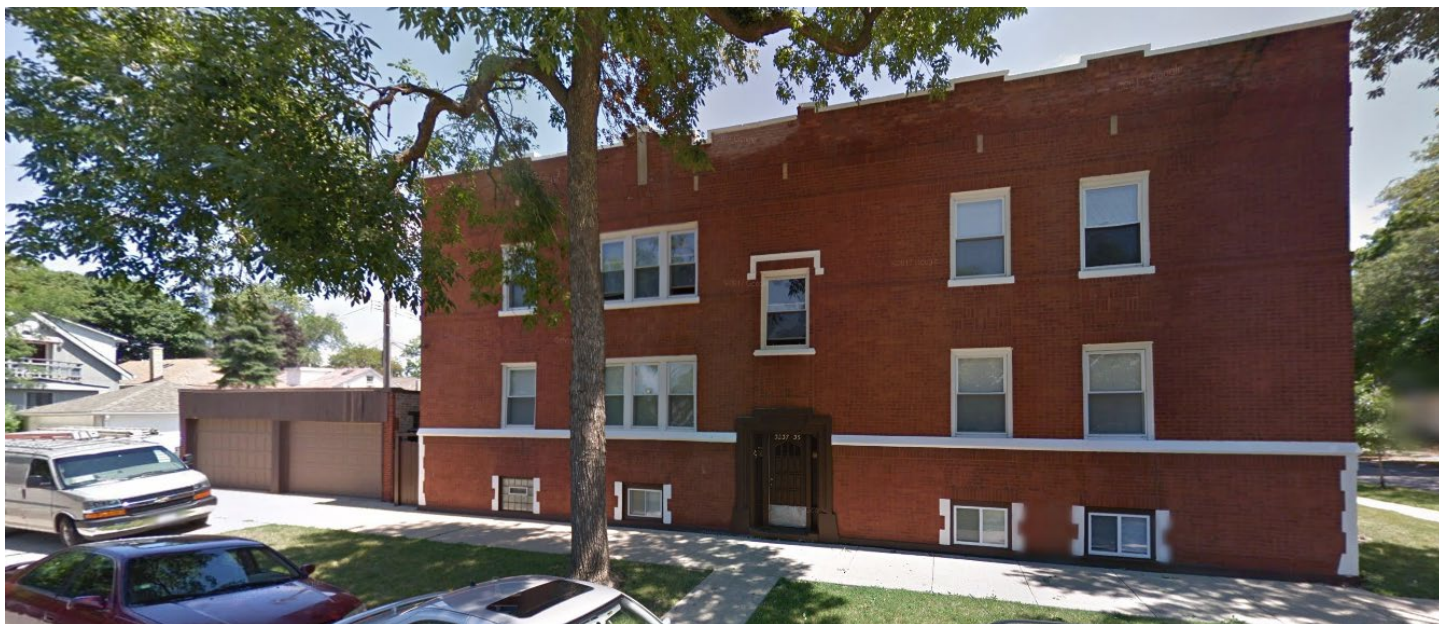

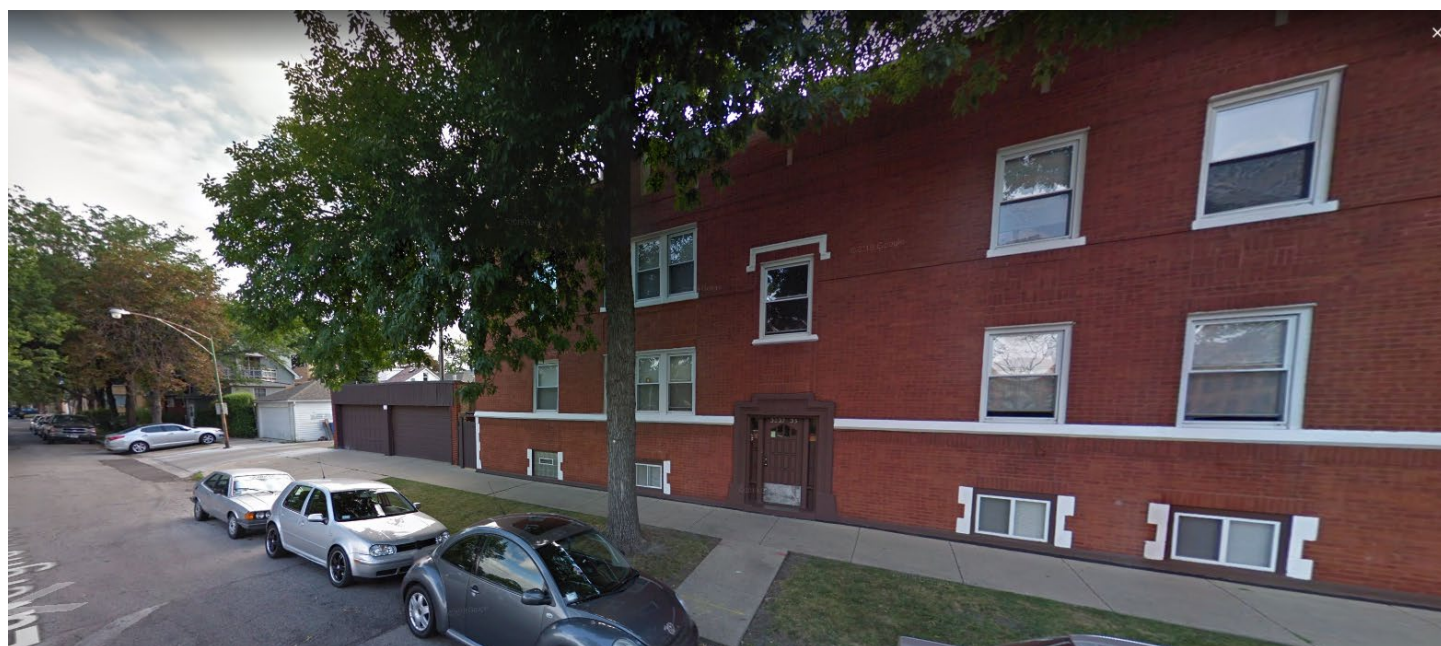
