A Royal Proclamation

(to declare the De'Jure Kingdom of England 927-1707 in a State of Emergency)

Hear Ye Hear Ye,

King Clifford Jefferson (Geoffrey), ascendant and descendant from The House of Plantagenet, Heirs of John I, son of Henry II, son of Geoffrey V, Count of Anjou. (Time Immemorial - Richard I 1189 A.D.)

To all Local Governments, such as Villages, Borough, Townships, Municipalities, Counties, including but not limited to their Agencies, Departments, Offices, including but not limited to their Officers, Agents and Assignees. The English Church of England, now known as The Third Temple English Church of England, and its members pursuant to 16:1-28 are subject of the parishes of Jersey, and not a township, which is a redundant term, contrast to parishes In England, a township (Latin: villa) is a local division or district of a large parish containing a village or small town usually having its own church. The Township Act of 1798 is ("An Act incorporating the Inhabitants of Townships, designating their Powers, and regulating their Meetings", PL 1798, p. 289), which is an Act passed by New Jersey Legislature on February 21, 1798 that formally incorporated 104 municipalities in 13 counties in New Jersey. It set standards on format for government of townships. The act was largely replaced by subsequent laws. The Township of Woodbridge is the oldest original township in New Jersey and was granted a royal charter on June 1, 1669, by King Charles II of England. It was reincorporated on October 31, 1693. Woodbridge Township was incorporated by the Township Act of 1798 of the New Jersey Legislature on February 21, 1798
