They rode in the Davis Motors Model T-3, the Time Travelers' Trolley. The Trolley, actually a tricked-out 8-passenger golf cart rebuilt by long-time Friends' volunteer Mike Davis, was described as "a futuristic e-vehicle combined with Victorian architecture to make the perfect transport for any family." Be sure to notice the Venus flytraps decorating the Trolley. The flytraps were a craft project made by teens under the direction of Librarians Loretta Gibson and Marisa Lowe. Treasurer: Susan Casey Davis (right) is another California native. She began volunteering for the Friends back in 1998. She has served as President, Vice-President and in other Board positions.






Beneath all that hair (or straw) was Friends' President Sharron Watson as Cousin It.

Friends' Book Store now accepts credit cards

Friends of the Poway Library is now able to accept most major credit cards for purchases in the Friends' Book Store. According to Book Store Manager John Williams, the time was finally right. "We have successfully operated the Book Store for more than twenty years on a strictly cash basis, but as fewer and fewer people carry cash, it has become an inconvenience for our customers," said Williams. "It also helps that credit card processors have become so much easier for our volunteers to use."

There is a 35 cent-per-transaction fee to help defray the cost of processing credit card charges.

Funds raised in the Friends' Book Store support the Poway Community Library in the purchase of books, DVDs and other materials for the Library collection, plus funding a wide range of Library programming for children, teens and adults.

Please stop by the Book Store soon and buy lots of books. You can put them on your credit card!



Moving boxes (and boxes . . . and *more* boxes) of books can be a real work-out. Setting up our Courtyard Sales requires moving literally hundreds of boxes of books from storage to the Library Meeting Room, and then, on the morning of the sale, moving them again from the Meeting Room to the Courtyard.
