

Winchester Country Pool Rules – Keep for your reference

1. All rules apply to both adults and children (Homeowners / Renters / Guests).
2. Only registered Winchester Country residents and their guests will be allowed to use the pool. You must have a zero balance on your account and a yearly pool registration form must be turned into the Clubhouse Office.
3. You must have your own working card to enter the pool. Lifeguards will not open the gate for anyone and you may not enter with someone else's card.
4. You are limited to 4 guests per household, a household member must accompany and stay with all guests at the pool. (A guest is considered anyone without a card, even if they live in the neighborhood, and any family member visiting your home). Guests will be required to sign in upon entry to the pool.
5. The telephone in the lifeguard office is for emergency use only.
6. Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
7. The baby pool is restricted to non-swimming children who are under the age of 6.
8. Non-swimming children must stay within arm's reach of an adult in both the baby pool and large pool. Even if they have on life jackets. Only 2 non-swimmers per adult will be allowed.
9. All non-potty-trained children must wear swim diapers at all times provided by the Residents.
10. Parents or guardians are responsible for children and/or guests in both the baby pool and large pool at all times. Lifeguards are there for your safety.
11. Running is not allowed in the pool area. No horseplay will be tolerated either in or out of the water. No throwing hard balls or objects in the pool area. No oversized floating devices.
12. Glassware/glass containers are not allowed in the pool area. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool or on the premises.
13. No grills are allowed. Pool guests are responsible for cleaning up their area. Please use facility trashcans to discard your trash. No red dye products are allowed.
14. Abusive/offensive language or gestures and/or racial slurs will not be tolerated. No offensive music.
15. Smoking is not allowed in or around the pool facility.
16. All persons younger than 18 years of age will leave the water during the scheduled hourly lifeguard break/adult swim period. Underage swimmers must sit away from the pool edge with their feet out of the water.
17. All swimmers must wear swim suits. No regular clothes are allowed in the pool. Water clothes are ok.
18. Only Coast Guard approved floatation devices are allowed, and they must be approved by the lifeguard staff. All non-swimmers must wear coast guard approved floatation devices.
19. A person with bandages and/or open sores will not be allowed in the pool.
20. Cocoa butter, baby oil or other similar products will not be allowed in the pool. Commercial suntan preparations only.
21. Animals are not allowed past the front gate of the pool area.
22. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen items or unclaimed items on the "Lost & Found" shelf. Unclaimed items will be disposed of throughout the pool season.
23. No climbing on the shade awning support poles or the perimeter fencing.
24. The lifeguards on duty will have the final authority for the enforcement of pool rules. The overall safe operations of the facility both explicit and implied by the pool rules must be obeyed at all times by adults and children.
25. Any undermining of the lifeguard's authority (explicit or implied) or disrespect towards lifeguards will not be tolerated.
