<u>Fun Facts:</u>

Virtually all of the plant life that is common to the northeastern United States can be found in New Jersey, and many rare plant species grow in the marshes and Pine Barrens, including some insectingesting plants. The Barrens are dominated, however, by oak and pine on the well-drained sites and by White cedar in the poorly drained bogs.
