

THE CAT LOUNGE INTAKE INFORMATION

Thank you for reaching out to The Cat Lounge Rescue and Adoption Center. Given the nature of our facility, we are limited to the types of cats we can take in. Please review the guidelines below. If the cat you are seeking help for falls within the criteria, we are happy to consider them.

Behavioral

The Cat Lounge is a public facility where cats free roam in a large room and the public is able to come in and out as they please. As such, we can only take in cats that are social and able to be handled. We cannot take in cats that hiss, swat, bite, cannot be held, cannot be pet, or will not do well in a busy environment with other cats.

Medical

We do have an isolation room for sick cats and have the resources to take in cats with minor medical cases: eye infections, URI, worms, diarrhea. However, we cannot take in cats that are FeLV/FIV positive, in need of major surgery, have a highly contagious condition, or will require extensive isolation and medical care.

Adult cats must be fixed prior to admittance to the Lounge (unless for medical reasons or nursing). Kittens under 12 weeks do not have to be fixed prior to arrival.

Age

We are able to take in cats of any age with the exception of newborns without mothers. With prior approval, it may be possible to take in bottle babies depending on the season.

Because of the large amount of request we receive, we cannot guarantee follow-up pictures, post adoption pictures, or updates after their intake. If you feel we are the right fit, please send us all available medical information and pictures of the cat(s) being handled to: info@thecatlounge.org. Please note: If, upon arrival of the cat, the Lounge determines the cat does not fall into our criteria, we will require the cat to be returned.
