Minutes, May 12, 2025

Call to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Mark Sander, also present were supervisors Jon Maker and Mark Labowski

Pledge to flag

Minutes from April 28, 2025 approved ~ Motion to accept/Mark L, 2nd/Jon, all in favor

ROADS AND EQUIPMENT: Started roadside mowing, began ditching on Greeley Road, planed Sciota/Greeley/Simmons roads, started graveling Simmons, normal maintenance on equipment

ZONING AND BUILDING: No new requests

CORRESPONDENCE: Erie County Department of Health is beginning annual flea/tick/mosquito monitoring and subsequent treatment in affected areas

OLD BUSINESS:

- Question of legality of political signs from a visitor was answered by Mark S. ~ political signs are treated as on-premise signs requiring no permit, can't be bigger than 32 square feet
- Messenger Road issue resolved, the trucker using it will cease to use Messenger/Turnpike Road extension
- The township has an opening on the Vacancy Board and is looking for a replacement

NEW BUSINESS:

- Nuisance violation letters mailed to three township residents
- Sinrae Goodwill submitted an offer letter to mow Wheelock Cemetery this year for \$400; motion to accept/Jon, 2nd/Mark S., all in favor
- A letter from the RDA of Corry detailing a grant opportunity was discussed; Mark S asked the secretary to find out if it would cover any of the cost of developing a new comprehensive plan
- Roadmaster Logan Mather described his idea to adapt our existing storage building for sand storage by stacking concrete barrier blocks along the back wall, leveling the floor and other adjustments and creating a dry storage area; three quotes were received, however two of them wouldn't deliver the product, Mark Sander made a motion, Jon seconded, all in favor of getting 18 blocks at @ \$100/each from Dennis Rickerson, who will deliver

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF VISITORS: Gerri Wellington, William Wellington, Jack Hasbrouck/Corry Journal

- Mr. Wellington wanted to know if we do a road survey to check for water on the roads, ditches and hanging trees ~ supervisors said we do, the roadmaster was asked and has completed one for 2025
- Mr. and Mrs. Wellington advised supervisors of the condition of the road they live on, saying the ditch is full, there's no ditch to speak of and when it rains two cars can't pass
- Mr. Wellington reported there is a new contractor sign on the south side of Route 6 by the auction and asked about setback rules, Mark S explained the rules are the same as for political signs
