

## **WAYNE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS**

### **Minutes July 13, 2026**

Call to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Mark Sander, also present were Supervisors Ray Wiggers and Jon Maker

Pledge to flag

An executive session was held prior to this meeting to discuss our comprehensive plan

Minutes approved from June 22, 2026, motion/Mark, 2<sup>nd</sup>/Jon, all in favor

ROADS AND EQUIPMENT: graded Russell, Bemis, Messenger, Turnpike Road Extension, Wheelock, Stateline West; graveling Sciota now, grading Mill Road this week and graveling, normal maintenance in shop and on equipment

ZONING AND BUILDING: None

CORRESPONDENCE: A letter from Eastern Alliance announcing the potential for increased rates in 2027; an email was received from the county RDA asking for help to develop a countywide inventory of available sites and land that may support future business; an email from McKean Township asking local municipalities covered by the CoStars salt contract to join with them challenging the huge price increase going into this winter, by meeting with local representatives and trying to get answers from CoStars

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

- Supervisors reviewed the recent tire recycling event and deemed it a success
- A proposed service agreement with Canadohta Security was declined

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- Notice from Erie County Department of Planning and Community Development/Planning Commission, proposing amendments to the county's SALDO which are already approved for adoption by the County Planning Commission and sent to local municipalities not covered by a SALDO of their own for review and comment
- A request was received from the City of Corry for a reciprocal letter of support, showing our ongoing support and cooperation with them to provide aid when needed during emergency situations or times of need with available resources; letters like this help municipalities when applying for grants; supervisors voted to write the letter, and will await receipt of a similar letter from the city ~ Motion/Mark, 2<sup>nd</sup>/Jon, all in favor
- Supervisors signed Resolution #26-09 to create and participate in a South County Emergency Medical Services Committee being developed and spearheaded by the Borough of Union City; Wayne's representative will be Mark Sander, alternate Jon Maker ~ Motion/Jon, 2<sup>nd</sup>/Ray, all in favor
- Logan reported on replacing a sluice pipe on Stateline Road, received a preliminary quote of \$4,600 from Interstate for 2' diameter pipe, which falls under the threshold for bidding
- Logan asked supervisors to approve him talking to PennDOT about switching the roads we maintain for them during the winter; they OK'd him talking to our PennDOT contact
- Supervisors asked the roadmaster if he made a deal with Union Township to give up our maintenance agreement with Turnpike Road extension; he explained that they came to him and he talked to their road crew about putting our gravel on a road we don't own but

maintain; we will continue to plow, but the road needed a substantial amount of base to get it back to where it should be; he said Union agreed to put a base on the road and top it with what gravel we have; he had it worked up and agreed upon and they called him, they did their part and put 4" base, time for us to put gravel on it, told them they could use the gravel in our pit, but if it wasn't enough they had to use their own; Supervisor Sander asked if next year we were going back to grading and taking care of road, he wasn't sure if that's how it's going to go, they said they'd build it up and we would still plow it, Wayne Township graded to the line; supervisors advised him to find another road to maintain or continue to maintain this section of road; roadmaster doesn't have any problem plowing it, just didn't want to use our gravel on the road; no specific answer to summer maintenance going forward

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF VISITORS: Lloyd Whitman, William Wellington, Tom Hellyer

- Mr. Wellington voiced his disapproval of the supervisors holding an executive session
- Mr. Wellington expressed his disapproval of the need for paperwork between municipalities to show their support for each other; there used to be a COG and that didn't work out
- Mr. Wellington brought up a grant seminar being held on July 29 at McKean Hose Company with Rep. Jake Banta; secretary is already registered for it
- Mr. Wellington asked if a driveway permit was issued for a parcel of land on Country Club Road ~ Supervisor Sander said yes
- Mr. Wellington wanted to know if he could get a copy of the minutes at each meeting; supervisors explained we can't hand them out until they're approved, Mr. Wellington alleges there's some missing from the website, supervisors explained the website is up to date
- Mr. Wellington asked who was hired to fill a road maintenance position, how much he is being paid, are we are paying for his CDL and what experience does he have
