- Mr. Wellington commented he didn't know how the township got away with meeting before a regular meeting, Chairman Sander replied the budget meeting was advertised as required in the Corry Journal, Mr. Wellington replied he doesn't get the paper; Mr. Wellington also questioned why the budget meeting was held in the office instead of the meeting room, Chairman Sander explained that's where the computer is and we need it to answer any questions that arise; Mr. Wellington was advised there will be a second budget meeting before the next regular meeting on Nov. 10, open to the public
