Call to order at 7:00 pm by Vice-Chairman Jon Maker, also in attendance was Supervisor Ray Wiggers; Chairman Mark Sander was excused

Pledge to flag

Minutes approved from August 10, 2026, motion/Jon, 2nd/Ray, all in favor

ROADS AND EQUIPMENT: Finished graveling on Stuart road, expect to grade and brine this week; put new injector seal and valve cover gasket on grader; took truck 9 to get new wing installed at Trux; completed inventory of shop for insurance purposes, will create spreadsheet

ZONING AND BUILDING: None

CORRESPONDENCE: Penelec replacing lines in township, crossing Hatchery and King Roads, all aerial work, no ditching/trenching

OLD BUSINESS:

- Additional quotes for pipe on Stateline Road: \$8,740 Interstate (original quote), Green Distributors \$9,268, JMI \$9,520 and Keystone Diversified Pipe \$9,620.66; supervisors discussed the pros and cons of buying the pipe now and storing it, vs. paying for it and leaving it at supplier vs. doing the project before winter; after consideration, they decided to table the matter until Supervisor Sander is present at the next meeting
- Update on freight charges for wing plow, Logan reported it would be about \$600 to ship, Supervisor Wiggers said he would be able to pick it up from Cleveland with his equipment when it's ready, most likely in December
- Turbo quotes for 2008 truck: Campbell's Garage \$3,800 for the turbo/\$4,500 installed and will make appointment if we want it; Diesel Creek would charge the same, but they would try to find an aftermarket turbo for less, so total would be less; Jon made a motion to award bid to Diesel Creek, 2nd/Ray

NEW BUSINESS:

- Vote on VanTassel SFTF changes ~ minor changes were approved by the supervisors and will be returned to the DEP ~ motion/Jon, 2nd/Ray
