- Workers comp quote from Loesel/Schaaf (currently through AmTrust), premium for 2025 was \$7,545, renews in October, must provide 60-day notice if switching carriers, savings of \$3,384 between current and new quote; supervisors tabled a vote, asked secretary to send them the full new quote package to review, will vote at next meeting
