Call to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Mark Sander, also present were Jon Maker and Mark Labowski

Minutes from July 28, 2025 approved ~ Motion to accept/Jon, 2nd/Mark L

ROADS AND EQUIPMENT: Graded and brined Wheelock Rd., currently graveling Greeley and Simmons roads, took both big trucks for inspection, maintenance work on equipment, including greasing and washing, second round of mowing has begun

ZONING AND BUILDING: (1) request for new pole building (storage), (2) requests for trailers in Route 6 mobile home park ready to occupy

CORRESPONDENCE: Three different cable contractors working in township for Spectrum

OLD BUSINESS:

- Aprons ~ already 22 municipalities signed up for joint quote from Suit-Kote through our engineer,
 if we are interested in joining in, would need to give an answer within a month; supervisors agreed
 to table the matter so they can tour the township and decide which, if any, roads/aprons need
 attention and revisit at the next meeting
- Putting concrete in salt shed before concrete blocks go in, received two quotes: If we pour halfway back quote is \$8,900 and if we do whole of one side quote is \$13,800

NEW BUSINESS:

- Supervisors signed off on three subdivision plans approved by Planning Committee (Troyer to Hurd 1.98 acres), Schrecengost to Sawyer and Heslink to Dietz .695 acres)
- Vote on appointment of Richard Warner to Vacancy Committee, motion/Mark S, 2nd/Mark L, all in favor
- Vote on appointment of township secretary as zoning officer effective June 1, 2025, motion/Mark S, 2nd/Mark L, all in favor
- Vote on appointment of Mike Marsh to Planning Committee for a four-year term, motion/Mark S, 2nd/Jon, all in favor
- Township was awarded county winter maintenance funds of \$7,745.00
- Rain running under maintenance garage door where loader is stored, does the building need qutters? Tabled until next meeting
- PennDOT has notified us Compass Minerals was awarded the 2025-2026 sodium chloride (salt) contract, price per ton will be \$59.62 (3.9% higher than this year), CoStars website not open for orders yet
- PennDOT Winter Maintenance Agreement signed, 10-year contract, first five years is contract, every year after that renewable for another year for 10 years, have option to opt-out, same roads as this year, 15.820 miles (Sciota, Simmons, Plank, Buffalo, Conelway, Washington St. extension) \$43,210.53 total; motion to accept/Mark S, 2nd/Jon, all in favor
- Township has filed for an RDA grant to help toward creating our new comprehensive plan, and will apply for a MAP grant to aid with costs also

Jan Baker inquired about building/zoning permits for deck repairs or replacements, Mark S.
explained the zoning/building permit process, whether someone needs a zoning and/or a building
permit and some of the criteria to look for; she also asked if permitting is needed to take down
trees

- Sandy Parkhurst asked about an orange barrel that's been on the blacktop near the intersection of Bemis Road and Simmons Road, wondered if the road was going to be fixed; since the barrel is on the blacktop, responsibility is PennDOT; supervisors asked secretary to contact PennDOT to get an answer to her question, and alert them that nothing has been done since the barrel was placed
- Mr. Wellington complimented our employee who mows the berms/trims trees along the roads, said
 he's doing a good job; he also asked when township was going to get bucket truck and trim
 branches, supervisors responded they're working on it
