Call to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Mark Sander, supervisors Jon Maker and Mark Labowski

- Mr. Wellington spoke about possibly oiling roads, someone he spoke with in Freehold Twp. said they pay \$200 for 200' of oil on roads, applied at night, no chips; supervisor Mark Sander asked him to get specific roads this procedure was used on, so he could go and look at them
- Heather VanTassel Olson of Wheelock Road advised supervisors she is upset with how the township ditched her road, alleging the process cut off access to her barn/field, wants it fixed and suggested township pre-notify residents when projects like this are going to be done; supervisors responded that the road was properly ditched and if any township residents purchase sluice pipe, the township will install and provide gravel for \$250.
- Cpl. Bordonaro of the PSP addressed the supervisors and guests, talked about cooperation between the state police and township residents, wants to put a face to the state police, encouraged residents to contact them with concerns
