Call to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Mark Sander, also present were Supervisors Mark Labowski and Jon Maker

Minutes from November 24, 2025 approved ~ Motion to accept/Mark L, second/Mark S., all in favor

ROADS AND EQUIPMENT: Roadmaster ~ salted and plowed roads as needed, ordered more salt, new blades on trucks, checked ditches for drainage issues

ZONING AND BUILDING: None

CORRESPONDENCE: NW REC increased rates effective January 1, 2026, generation/transmission goes from \$.05449 to \$.07601 per KWH, distribution rate remains the same; State lawmakers voted themselves a 3.5% cost of living raise effective Dec. 1, 2025

OLD BUSINESS:

- Second notice from our MAP grant application: The Spring 2025 awards were announced, but the deadline to submit the Fall 2025 grants was extended to Nov. 1 because the state budget hadn't been passed yet, awards most likely in January 2026, then 8-12 weeks before receipt

NEW BUSINESS:

- Supervisors voted to accept Erie County tax office's request for a tax-free, lien-free sale of property in the township, valued at \$2,300 with tax forgiveness of \$901.95 for unpaid taxes 2021 through 2024; Motion/Jon, 2nd/Mark S
- A newly-elected supervisor has declined to take office in 2026 for personal reasons, write-in candidate Ray Wiggers indicated he would be willing to serve; uncertified/unofficial results of the election showed 311 votes for Mr. Carr and 101 write-in votes for Mr. Wiggers; Mark Sander made a motion to appoint Raymond Wiggers as the new supervisor for a two-year term beginning January 1, 2026, he will run again in 2027 for a 4-year term to complete the 6-year term for the position ~ 2nd by Mark L, all in favor
- New PennDOT bidding thresholds for 2026 were reviewed
- Supervisors opened demolition quotes for a property at 17310 Route 89 ~ Lipchik Excavation and Demolition \$23,750, Bill Jackson Excavating \$15,500, Bengel Excavating LLC \$11,000; the contract was awarded to Bengel Excavating, with work to begin as soon as possible ~ Motion/Mark S, 2nd/Jon, all in favor
