Minutes, August 25, 2025

Call to order at 7:00 pm by Chairman Mark Sander, also present were Jon Maker and Mark Labowski

Pledge to flag

Minutes from August 11, 2025 approved ~ Motion to accept/Mark S, 2nd/Jon

ROADS AND EQUIPMENT: Graveled, graded Greeley, graveled Simmons, general maintenance on equipment, worked on loader; Mark L noted there is a massive pothole at the end of Buffalo and Stateline roads that needs attention

ZONING AND BUILDING: None

CORRESPONDENCE: TriState Auction has scheduled an equipment auction on September 20; supervisors discussed, decided to wait until Spring to see if we want to send anything

OLD BUSINESS:

- Aprons ~ Supervisors discussed joining in a group quote through our engineer to pave the aprons on township roads. After reviewing the possibilities, they voted to get quotes for the intersections of Mill and Plank Roads, Buffalo and Stateline Roads; Motion made by Mark S, 2nd/Jon, all in favor
- Supervisors talked about pros and cons of pouring concrete in utility building before installing barrier blocks vs. leaving the dirt floor: 19x35 pad (8" thick/rebar, plastic) would be \$8900, if we pour all the way back 19x56 (8" thick with rebar/plastic) cost would be \$13,800, barriers would be installed down the middle; concrete will make it easier to collect the salt; installation would be by Maleski Wood Processing. Motion made by Mark S to install 19x56 pad, 2nd/Jon, Mark L voted no

NEW BUSINESS:

- Discussion of quote for \$8,000 in parts to repair our loader; tabled until next meeting, supervisors want other quotes and would like to have the roadmaster present to give details
