- We've only been owners for a year. Is there a publication that highlights those groups you support? I looked on the website after talking with John F. I was unaware of how much you do for the community. It's different than our Employee Relations Committee, and I can understand if part-timers support it more than the greater community. I assume many support charities in the communities in which they live in the summer/fall. A challenge to get them to support both!
- You're doing a great thing. Keep it up.
- Share the survey results with all members when completed.
- The Spring Run Charitable Foundation does an excellent job supporting worthwhile causes.
- You do a great job!
- Need to interest more members in participating and volunteering in the SRCF.
- We enjoy the golf, home tours, & make donations, but I am an anti-auction. Our local community has 10 different auctions per year & I have been burned both on the donation & purchasing ends of the auction experience.
- Limit donations to organizations that keep total overhead expenses to less than 10% of the total money raised.
- This year's Main Event was extremely expensive but only \$30 per meal was going to SRCF. That
 percentage of my ticket price that went to the charities was very disappointing. I would rather
 have a less elaborate event where more money went to the charities. Consequently, we did not
 attend.
- The auction items are fabulous but too costly for most members to afford.
- I feel the SRCF needs to be scaled back so more of members' money is actually going to the charities.
- SRCF is not the only charity we donate to. Since we have two homes, we have organizations we support in our hometown.
- Can the foundation do more to help SR employees. They are a very dedicated group and deserve our assistance where and when it is needed.

- I believe that we are trying to support too many charities. Trim the list and increase support for those charities that function mainly in Lee County.
- It's wonderful to see what SRCF has accomplished, and we support as best as we can through monetary donations.
- The foundation needs to do its homework when selecting charities to support. In no case should we fund charities where more than 10% of the funds raised go to overhead, including salaries.
- I would be happy to volunteer for the Homes Tour.
- We always used to bid & win local vacations using the silent auctions. This was a way of donating without attending the live auction. Bring that back??
- Too many events.
- Events have become too expensive.
- Members feel pressure to participate.
- While the chosen charities do good work, you should provide more info on how effective they use our money, ie: admin costs vs program spending, independent ratings, etc.
- I volunteer at New Horizons. I'd love to see more SR folks volunteer at any of these charities.
- Great work is being done through SRCF.
- The dinner held at the Main Event last year was very expensive. I think some members did not
 attend because of the cost. Lower the price & get more people to attend & get caught up in the
 bidding. We are at an age where we can't eat as much as we used to. We would rather spend
 some money bidding.
- John, I have already suggested to you and Patty an active effort to bring younger residents into
 the SRCF Board and committees. Getting younger members involved creates buy-in, a sense of
 involvement and a willingness to reach out to their peers ... other younger members.
- We love the ease of one big contribution that the foundation chooses for us. Easier than searching ourselves.
- We enjoy continuing our philanthropy here in Florida.
