

SRCF ANNUAL REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY 2020-2021

Spring Run Charitable Foundation has just completed its 14th year of fundraising for Local Charities in Lee and Collier Counties and what a year it has been! Despite the COVID-19 cancellations we had our best fundraising year ever. Our Cash Raffle, Golf Outing, outdoor Live Auction, monetary donations from Spring Run's residents, and local businesses enabled SRCF to distribute \$202,000 in 2021.

COLLIER/LEE COUNTY HONOR FLIGHT - \$500

Collier-Lee Honor Flight's mission is to transport local Veterans to Washington, D.C. to visit the memorials dedicated to honor their service and sacrifices.

DUCKLINGS TRAVEL, INC - \$5,000

Ducklings Travel, Inc. provides financial travel aid for non-life threatening, yet debilitating medical conditions to ensure that no child is denied access to specialized medical attention due to travel expenses.

HARRY CHAPIN FOOD BANK - \$25,000

Their mission is to lead our community in the fight to end hunger.

INTERFAITH CHARITIES OF SOUTH LEE - \$30,000

Monies provide a food pantry, financial assistance, budget classes, transportation, free income tax services, summer lunch for kids, and Meals on Wheels to those in need.

LACES OF LOVE - \$26,500

Since 2008 over 200,000 pairs of shoes have been distributed to disadvantaged children in Lee and Collier Counties. In the past two (2) years the money donated by **Spring Run Charitable Association**, has enabled Laces of Love to deliver 1,200 pairs of those shoes to children in need.

LEE HEALTH AT COCONUT POINT - \$10,000

Spring Run has sponsored a state of the art balancing machine in the physical therapy department.

MIDWEST FOOD BANK-FLORIDA - \$25,000

Their mission is to alleviate hunger and malnutrition locally and provide disaster relief; all without discrimination

NEW HORIZONS - \$30,000

New Horizons is committed to empower at-risk youth to reach their full potential through tutoring, mentoring, and faith.

OPERATION OPEN ARMS - \$30,500

Their mission is to support Active Duty Servicemen/women and Veterans with special needs; to provide R&R, and a range of services to contribute to their health and well-being.

SPRING RUN CHARITABLE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND - \$10,000

This charity provides scholarships to Spring Run employees and their children in pursuit of further education. We had 2 qualified applicants this year.
