

# SRCF ANNUAL REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY 2023-2024

Spring Run Charitable Foundation has just completed its 18th year of fundraising for Local Charities in Lee and Collier Counties. Once again we have had a very successful year! The Cash Raffle, Golf Outing, Main Event, Live Auction, monetary donations and sponsorships from Spring Run residents, and local businesses enabled SRCF to distribute \$162,590 to our selected charities in 2024.

### INTERFAITH CHARITIES OF SOUTH LEE - \$20,000

Monies provide a food paritry, financial assistance, budget classes, transportation, free income tax services, summer lunch for kids, and Meals on Wheels to those in need.

#### LACES OF LOVE - \$22,000

Since 2008 over 200,000 pairs of shoes have been distributed to disadvantaged children in Lee and Collier Counties. In the past two (2) years the money donated by **Spring Run Charitable Association**, has enabled Laces of Love to deliver 1,200 pairs of those shoes to children in need.

## ANA'S FRIENDS - \$20,050.

ANA's Friends serves Abused Neglected and Abandoned children in Southwest Florida. Formerly known as the Guardian ad Litem Foundation — 20th Judicial Circuit, A.N.A.'s Friends works tirelessly to provide vulnerable young individuals with the support, care, guidance and resources they need to overcome adversity and build brighter futures.

### OPERATION OPEN ARMS - \$25,500

Their mission is to support Active Duty Servicemen/women and Veterans with special needs; to provide R&R, and a range of services to contribute to their health and well-being.

## NEW HORIZONS - \$20,000

New Horizons is committed to empower at-risk youth to reach their full potential through tutoring, mentoring, and faith.

# SPRING RUN CHARITABLE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND - \$15,000

This charity provides scholarships to Spring Run employees and their children in pursuit of further education. We had 5 qualified applicants this year each receiving \$7,500.

# TRI-COUNTY ATHLETES - \$10,000

Tri-County Athletes gives physically and mentally challenged young adults a chance to be part of a team and turn their challenges into success stories.

# HARRY CHAPIN FOOD BANK - \$20,040

Their mission is to lead our community in the fight to end hunger.
