

FACTS	WHAT DOES ABSOLUTE DEBT RELIEF LLC (“ADR”) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Social Security number and income • Account balances and payment history • Credit history and credit score
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons ADR chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does ADR protect my personal information?	<p>To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.</p> <p>provide or allow us access to your account information</p> <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes— information about your creditworthiness</p> <p>affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</p> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p>Our affiliates include financial companies such as Beyond Finance, LLC and KCK FS Investments, LLC; non-financial companies like parent holding companies and indirect parent entity.</p>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <p>Non-affiliates we share with can include lenders, lending networks, financial institutions, service providers, direct marketing companies and other financial product and service providers</p>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <p>Our joint marketing partners include lenders, lending networks, financial institutions, service providers, direct marketing companies and other financial product and service providers.</p>
Other important information	
<p>State laws may also provide you with specific privacy protections. Please note those individual circumstances below that may apply to you. We will comply with applicable state laws with respect to our use of your information.</p> <p>For Alaska, Illinois, Maryland and North Dakota Customers: We will not share personal information with nonaffiliates either for them to market to you or for joint marketing-without your authorization.</p>	

California Residents: We will not share your personal information with non-affiliated third parties for their marketing purposes without your affirmative consent. Except as permitted by law, we will not share your personal information with our affiliates or joint marketing partners without first giving you additional privacy choices.

Nevada Residents: We are providing this notice to you pursuant to state law. You may be placed on our internal Do Not Call List by requesting that we cease calling you by contacting us directly and making such request in writing to privacy@absolutedr.com.
