

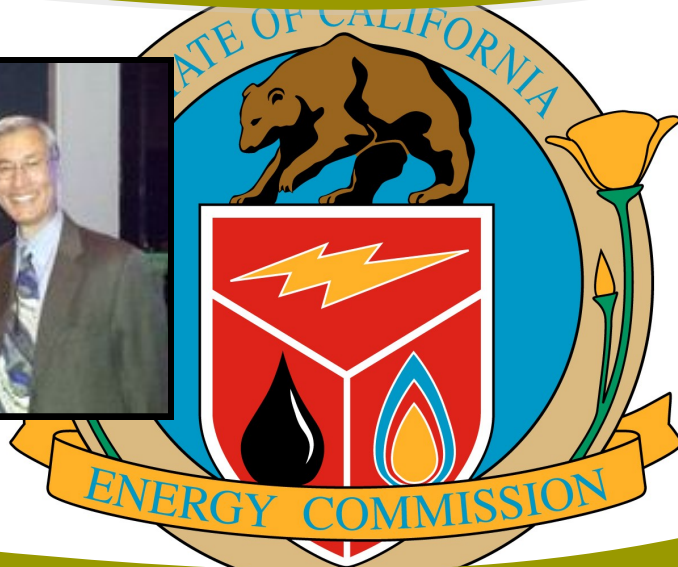

“Fundamentals and Potential of Variable Refrigerant Technology”

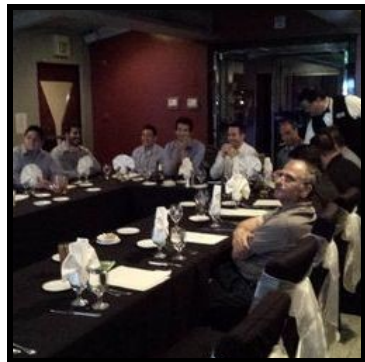
KYLE KENLEY, LEED AP, Mitsubishi Electric

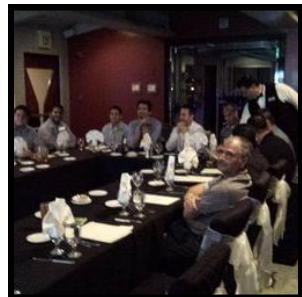


There were many on hand in October to hear about Title 24 changes that are coming in January. It was a great presentation by Randall Higa that had everyone engaged.
