MEETING PREVIEW



"What's New with 2013 Title 24 Building Energy Efficiency Standards"

RANDALL HIGA, P.E., LEED AP, Codes and Standards Program Manager at Southern California Edison

Randall Higa is a Program Manager Southern California Edison where he leads the Codes and Standards program. Prior to working at SCE, Randall worked at Southern California Gas Company managing various customer programs, regulatory proceedings, and energy efficiency programs and including the nonresidential new construction program. He began his engineering and architectural career at CTG Engineers and Albert C. Martin and Associates prior to embarking on his current utility career.

Randall is a USGBC and ASHRAE member and has previously served on the ASHRAE SPC 90.1 committee. In addition to being a licensed mechanical professional engineer, he is also a LEED accredited professional. Randall graduated from UCLA engineering where he studied mechanical engineering and thermal sciences.

The new Title 24, Part California Building Energy Efficiency Standards will go into effect on January 1, 2014. The Title 24 Standard is developed by the California Energy Commission (CEC) since the Warren-Alquist State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Act was signed into law by Governor Reagan. The Title 24 Standards are generally updated on a three-year cycle with the goal of having the residential Standard by zero net energy by 2020 and the nonresidential Standard by 2030. For just over 10 years, the California investor owned utilities have been actively supporting the efforts of the CEC in the development, implementation and training of Standards.

Presentation Topic — What's New with 2013 Title 24 Building Energy Efficiency Standards

The presentation will be an overview of the upcoming California 2013 Title 24 Building Energy Efficiency Standards that will become effective on January 1, 2014. It will focus on Nonresidential Standards and will include the description of the status of the new compliance software (based upon Energy Plus), the new areas of coverage (data centers, labs, kitchens, etc.), and the plans for meeting the upcoming net zero energy goals.


