

Craig was a member of the new Tri-County Chapter Steering Committee in 1988 and also the Southern California Chapter President during that time. Tony Occionero, Sukhdev Mathaudhu, Jeffrey Leonard, Del Thomas, and others actively headed the steering committee and were responsible for the details of the Chapter's formation.

Lou Flagg and the Tri-County Chapter: On December 13, 1988 Lou Flagg chartered the Tri-County Chapter of ASHRAE into existence as the Society President during that time. Lou served the Society for 50 years and received numerous awards until he passed away in 1999.
