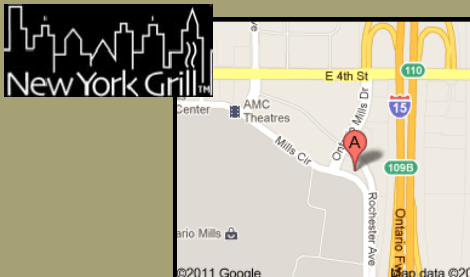

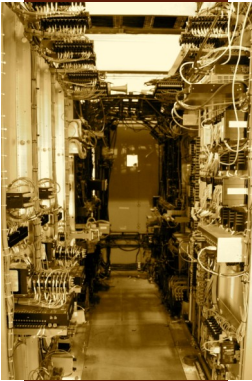

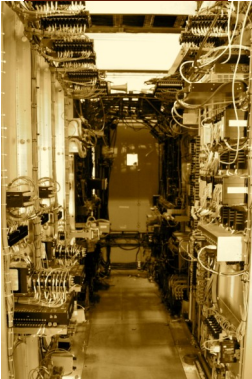


Dear Tri-County ASHRAE:

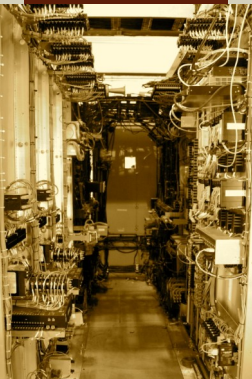
