



## Leadership recall



## Jim Toda took an opportunity to interview former chapter leader, Jeff Leonard, to get some insight into Tri-County's past.

Jeff Leonard served the Tri-County chapter of ASHRAE as chapter President, during the 1990-1991 season. Jeff was the second Tri-County President.

Jeff is currently the President of Leonard Engineering in Upland. Below is an interview with Jeff, which details some of the early years and various activities of Tri-County ASHRAE.

Jim Toda: Give me a little background on yourself and your family.

Jeff Leonard: I was born just south of Chicago. After I received a Mechanical Engineering degree from the University of Illinois, I worked in Springfield Illinois for five years. I then moved to Southern California. My wife Judy and I have a daughter Karen, two sons, Benjamin and Nicolas. Judy produced the Tri-County roster for the chapter into the late 90's.



- JT: What was your first job in the HVAC industry and where did it lead?
- JL: I worked for an HVAC Engineering firm, during the five years in Springfield Illinois. I came to Southern California to work for Store, Matakovich & Wolfberg, where I worked another five years. In 1987 I started Leonard Engineering, where I have worked since.
- JT: When did you get started in ASHRAE?
- JL: I was first a Student ASHRAE Member. My Refrigeration Professor Will Stoecker told me "You need to join ASHRAE". After college I went to some Southern California chapter meetings here and there. In 1988 I was asked to be part of the Steering Committee, to start the Tri-County chapter. I was chosen to be the President Elect/Programs Chair for the first two Tri-County chapter years (The first chapter year was only six months). It helped that the 1990 Chapters Regional Conference (CRC) was in Hawaii.
- JT: You were there from the beginning of Tri-County. What was Tri-County like during this time?
- JL: There were no precedents, so Tri-County got to set its own precedents. The involved members had to do plenty of outreach, to insure good attendance for the monthly meetings. We went to Engineering firms, contractors, and facilities, to spread the word about Tri-County ASHRAE. Committee members also did Membership promotion outreach, not just the Membership chair. For example, the Refrigeration chair while setting up a refrigeration tour, would promote the Tri-County chapter.

We sent questionnaires out each year to find out what programs our members wanted. We also asked other chapters what programs they recommended.

- JT: What other interests do you have?
- JL: I enjoy spending time with my family. My three grandchildren also keep me busy.
- JT: Do you have any comments you would like to make?
- JL: During good times and tough times, ASHRAE always allows us to learn, network, and broaden our view of HVAC. If you are entering the HVAC field, join ASHRAE and learn the fundamentals of HVAC design. Finally to recruit a Programs Chair, make sure the CRC is in Hawaii!
