Tri County Member History-Lou Horsefield

The 20th annual Lou Horsefield memorial scholarship was awarded to Alexander Rosales at our Student Night meeting last month (see picture below). Alex attends Cal Poly Pomona.

The Tri County chapter's favorite "Senior Student" member will always be Lou Horsefield, who passed away on October 31, 2005, from an automobile accident. Lou always made Tri County meetings more enjoyable with his presence and humor. The chapter certainly misses him!

Lou loved ASHRAE meetings. He would attend all four Southern California area chapters *each* month. He would go to the Southern California chapter the first Tuesday, the San Diego chapter the second Tuesday, the Tri County chapter the third Tuesday, and the Orange Empire chapter the fourth Tuesday.

Lou served the chapter a number of times, as a nominating committee member. He also regularly contributed to ASHRAE research, through the Tri County chapter.

The Tri County chapter of ASHRAE awards the Lou Horsefield memorial scholarship annually to our top scholarship recipient. Lou's wife Linne presented the first Lou Horsefield memorial scholarship, on April 18, 2006, to Ouma Moss.

Leadership recall interview with Mike Franzen

Mike Franzen was Tri-County ASHRAE chapter President during the 2020-2021 year. He provided excellent leadership during that time for our chapter. Mike is currently the President at Franzen Consulting. Below is an interview with Mike, which details some of his earlier years and various ASHRAE experiences.

Tell us about your education and early experience:

Mike: I attended Cal Poly \$an Luis Obispo starting in 1976 and graduated in 1979 with an Air Conditioning and Refrigeration degree. During that time, I worked at the Dana Ice Company in San Luis Obispo. I was building an ice plant stack at the factory.

What companies have you worked at in the HVAC industry?

Mike: My first job was at Schlaman Air Conditioning in Riverside. I then went to University of California, Riverside working as a Facility Energy Coordinator. I then was at Store Matakovich and Wolfberg from 1985 to 1995. After that, I was at P2S Engineering from 1995 to 1999. I was at Toft, Wolff, Farrow from 1999 to 2002. I was also at The Aerospace Corporation from 2002 to 2012. I worked as a Consulting Engineer from 2012 to 2015. I was then at S&K Engineers from 201 to 2020. I then started my company Franzen Consulting, where I continue to work.

How did serving as chapter President help you grow?

Mike: ASHRAE is like golf, where golf is physical mathematics, and Engineering is quantitative mathematics. ASHRAE is continued learning, and by being President and doing it we learn it.

What advice would you give students entering HVAC field?

Mike: Learn Graphic Pro programs and controls, and ALC Disk Tech. When I started as a HVAC Engineer, everything was done by hand. We did not have computers.

What other interests or hobbies do you have?

Mike: I like golfing. I used to be a 5-handicap golfer. I also like skiing and motorcycling.
