CREATION OF A TOUR CHAMPIONSHIP & THE IPS CUP

By the authority vested in me as President by the Constitution and laws of the Majors, and in order to increase the relative wealth of those golfers whose performance is consistently strong, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1: Creation of a Tour Championship & IPS Cup

In 2014, all Majors competitors will participate in the Tour Championship, with a chance to win “IPS Cup” and a cash prize.

While it may appear that this event bears resemblance to the PGA Tour’s Fed Ex Cup, archeological evidence, discovered in Kirok’s cave, indicates that the tenets of the IPS Cup pre-date the Fed Ex Cup. Legal recourse against the PGA Tour is being considered.

The Hoo Hoo Shoot will serve as both a standalone tournament and the Tour Championship.

Section 2: Participation & Qualification

Competitors from any of the 4 Majors are automatically entered into the Tour Championship and will compete for the IPS Cup. There is no qualification required. However, only those participants entered into the Hoo Hoo Shoot can mathematically win the IPS Cup.

Section 3: Accrual of Points

Points are awarded for Top 10 finishes in the first three majors (600, 400, 300, 200, 100, 50, 40, 30, 20, and 10). Point totals will be reset before the Hoo Hoo Shoot.

Points reset prior to the Hoo Hoo Shoot are as follows: 2500 for the current point leader, 2250 for second place, 2000, 1800, 1600, 1400, 1200, 1000, 800, 600, 480, 460...down by 20 until the end of the year's participant list.

Those individuals who only play in the Hoo Hoo Shoot will be set a points value of 20 points lower than the lowest number.

Point values for order of finish in the Hoo Hoo Shoot are as follows: 2500, 1500, 1000, 750, 550, 500, 450, 425, 400, 375, 350, 325

Section 4: Determination of a Champion

It is mathematically impossible to win the IPS Cup without playing in the Hoo Hoo Shoot. Additionally, it is also mathematically impossible for a Hoo Hoo Shoot Only player to win the IPS Cup.

Those individuals in the "Top 5" after the points reset control their destiny with regard to winning the IPS Cup.

The IPS Cup Winner will be the golfer with the most points following the completion of the Hoo Hoo Shoot.

Section 5: Payout

The IPS Cup will pay out to two places. The winner of the IPS Cup will receive \$100. Second place receives \$20.

Section 6: Entry Fee

There is no entry fee to participate in the 2014 IPS Cup.

Section 7: Etymology of IPS

IPS, or International Parcel Service, is the package delivery company that employs both Doug Heffernan and Deacon Palmer.
