MÁRIO DE BRAGA (or Mário Moita as he was known until 2022) He was born in the south of Portugal (Alentejo) in Reguengos de Monsaraz, and since he was 9 years old he has performed at major events in the city. He began his piano studies in 1981 at the Évora Music Academy, now a regional conservatory. It recovered the 1870's tradition of Fado to Piano around the world, having launched on April 17, 2007 at the Fado Museum the only CD book on this topic. In 1990 he founded Tuna Sons do Mar on Terceira Island (Azores) and in 1992 Tuna SeisTetos at the University of Évora. In 1999, she began to study singing with Professor João Costa Campos from the São Carlos choir (Lisbon Opera) and with Luis de Matos, a reference in singing in Portugal.

It has more than 2000 performances in 40 countries and 15 states in Brazil. Of his eleven albums (on cd) we highlight the cd fado Navegante distributed by London in 65 countries, and launched on the ship Escola Sagres da Marinha Portuguesa in October 201. His last live cd/DVD recorded at Teatro Ademir Rosa (CIC) in June 2018. And it's called Fado Clássico.

Long CV

Mário De Braga, (known for 40 years as Mário Moita), was born in Alentejo and from a very early age revealed his tendency towards musical art. At just 7 years old, he wins the gala of the small singers of the district of Évora and at the age of 9 he performs at parties in his homeland in Reguengos de Monsaraz for 3000 people, and begins his piano studies at the Évora Conservatory of Music with Prof. Maria de Lourdes Horta. He was fortunate enough to meet the pianist Furtunato Murteira, who was a contemporary of the great Fado composer Alberto Janes (also from his hometown of Reguengos de Monsaraz), and who left him his entire collection of Fados for Piano scores (he has the first

score of the fado It was God "Foi Deus"). In 1990 he joined Animal productions Engineer at the University of the Azores and founded a musical group that would give rise to Tuna Sons do Mar. 2 years later he returned to his Alentejo and founded the Tuna 6 Tetos at the University of Évora.

In 1993, he participated in the program Chuva de Estrelas on SIC, standing out for his romantic character. In 1995, he began his work as a Pianist at the magnificent Castelo da Rainha Santa Isabel in Estremoz, a beautiful 5-star hotel within the city's castle.

Always dedicated to fado on the piano, the result of the legacy of his master pianist Fortunato Murteira, Mário learned in Japan with the historian and friend Prof. Ito Genjiro broadcasting not "only" music but associating music with the culture and magnificent history of Portugal.

In 2003, he begins to participate in the great world music fairs and begins a new stage: to travel even further around the world representing Portugal in hundreds of Festivals and theaters around the world.

Today he has an incredible curriculum full of travels and television shows in more than 30 countries from Romania to Estonia, from Poland to Japan, passing through more than half of Brazil where he is very much loved by the media, namely JO SOARES, which has invited him several times to his famous talk show.
