BY-LAW # 360 OF THE VILLAGE OF MORRIN TO SET SPEED LIMITS WITH IN THE VILLAGE OF MORRIN BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS: the Municipal government Act, R.S.A. 2000, C-M-26 and amendments thereto, provides that a Municipality may pass bylaws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people and the protection of people and property.

WHEREAS: the Council of the Village of Morrin desires to pass a By-law to regulate speed limits within the Village of Morrin;

SECTION 1 – TITLE, PURPOSE AND SCOPE

- 1.1 This By-law shall be known as the "Speed Limit Bylaw"
- 1.2 The purpose of this Bylaw is to
 - (a) Set the speed limit for all roads and streets in the Village of Morrin.

SECTION 2 - DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw:

- 2.1 "Speed Limit" means the maximum speed legally permitted on a given street.
- 2.2 "Streets" means the parts of the Village of Morrin intended for vehicle traffic.

SECTION 3 - REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 The speed limit on all Village of Morrin streets shall be 30 km/hour at all times.
- 3.2 Speed limit signs of 30 km/hour will be posted on all entries to the Village.

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon the Third and Final Reading.

Read a First time this 30 day of June 2018.

Read a Second time this <u>20</u> day of <u>June</u> 2018.

Read a Third time and Finally passed this 20 day of June 2018.
