

VILLAGE OF MORRIN

BY LAW # 364

BEING A BYLAW TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL BYLAW # 352 FOR THE VILLAGE OF MORRIN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA.

WHERE AS: Pursuant to the provision of Section 191 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, the Council of the Village of Morrin have deemed it necessary to amend the Village Procedural By-Law # 352.

NOW THEREFORE: The Village of Morrin Council hereby amend the Procedural By-Law as follows:

1. Every written communication reaching the Mayor, CAO or other Officer and intended for Council shall be fairly written and printed on paper and shall contain the following information:
 - a. Name, signature, address and telephone number of person submitting the written communication.
 - b. Indication of what action is desired.
2. Any Council member, Municipal Official or any other person wishing to make a presentation but Has been unable to comply with requirements described in Section 2, may have their presentation placed on the agenda as a modification to the agenda approved by a vote at the meeting.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 20TH DAY OF MARCH, 2019.

READ A THIRD TIME AND PASSED THIS 20TH DAY OF MARCH, 2019.
