BY-LAW # 292 OF THE VILLAGE OF MORRIN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, CANADA.

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE WATER. SEWER AND REFUSE UTILIT IN THE VILLAGE OF MORRIN.

WHEREAS:

The Council of the Village of Morrin, under authority of the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26.1, 1994 and amendments thereto, it necessary to propose this establishment o rules and regulations governing the water, s and refuse utilities.

NOW THEREFORE:

The Council of the Village of Morrin in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, here-by enacts as follows:

- Water, sewer and refuse utility rates shall be set at Counci discretion by resolution of Council.
- There shall be a utility deposit of DOUBLE OF MONTHLY UTILITY RATE until such time as the deposit is received the fee for the utility service shall be billed to the land-owner.
- 3. All accounts for water, sewage and refuse service, shall be and payable when rendered. This service is liable to shut of in the event that an account is not paid with-in 60 days from the date that the account is rendered.
- 4. There shall be a charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) to h the water service turned back on after it has been officiall turned off, and all arrears owing must be paid in full.
- 5. All water service, unless officially turned off by the Villa Foreman shall be considered in use and charged accordingly.
- 6. Accounts for Water, Sewer and Refuse service shall be forwar monthly to the owner or occupier of property connected to the water works system and shall be payable at the Village Offic
- 7. Accounts shall be deemed to be sufficiently forwarded if the are mailed by ordinary mail to the owner or occupier at the known mailing address.
- 8. Any arrears outstanding on December 31 of any given year, macharged as taxes against a property and may be entered on the Assessment and Tax Roll by resolution of Council to the real property to which the water and sewer services have been supposed.
- All new accounts will receive a copy of this utility By-Law when their deposit is paid to the Village Office.
