



**COURSE:** Citizen Gunfighter Program (**CITGUN**)  
Held at the Integrated Special Operations Training Facility (ISOTF),  
Altha Florida **1-2 Sept 2019**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Citizen Gunfighter Program (CGP) referred to as "**CITGUN**" is a specialized personal survivability program developed by the TATSOR Group for the citizen and taught at the Integrated Special Operations Training Facility (ISOTF), Altha Florida.

"**CITGUN**" is presented by elite professionals from within military and law enforcement special operations that possess extensive operational/personal security/survival experience internationally.

Training will include a high energy, dynamic marksmanship buildup followed by integration into an interior tactics environment that will include dry and live fire applications. During the conduct of "**CITGUN**" each and every attendee's mind, body and spirit will be challenged through kinetic skills applications within training modules that are designed to bring the attendee as close to the "real world" environment as is possible.

**PURPOSE:** To teach attendees the knowledge and skills required identifying evolving threats with emphasis upon countering those threats in order to survive the high-risk encounter. The training will include but not be limited to:

- Introduction to "**CITGUN**"
- Introduction to the psychology of the high-risk encounter/high-risk threat event (the gunfight)
- Situational/tactical awareness
- Introduction to firearms (Handgun and AR platform or like weapon system)
- Marksmanship w/handgun and AR Platform or like weapon
- Offensive marksmanship-shooting tactics-techniques-procedures (TTPs)
- Interior tactics-techniques-procedures with emphasis on winning the gunfight
- High risk-encounter/high risk threat event scenarios (Interior)

**PRE-REQUISITES:** "**CITGUN**" attendees are individuals/groups with a desire and/or need-requirement for enhanced situational awareness and weapons handling skills in varied environments.

**CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION:** Class duration is 2 days (22 hours). The program is limited to 24 attendees. Program cost is **\$400.00** per attendee and includes lodging on the facility and (6) meals over the conduct of the program.



**PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:** Each "CITGUN" attendee requires the following items at a minimum:
