SRO-TAP Concept

The SRO-TAP involves a robust foundation and sustainment training program developed in conjunction with an organizations leadership that is ultimately taught/advised by a specialized contract training team/cell from the TATSOR Group. The oversight by the TATSOR Group also includes evaluations on the individual, subunit and collective levels with the desired end state of a collective organization validation (also conducted by the TATSOR Group).



SRO-TAP Concept



In today's ever changing world, it is vitally important for the law enforcement professional to be well trained and motivated in order to succeed. In the tactical arena, this is even more important. The Special Response Organizations (SRO) of the 21st century must be better trained, better motivated and capable of response on a moments notice with the ability to resolve a myriad of mission sets.

With the ever changing, highly dangerous criminal/terrorist threat operating in our communities, it has become even more important that the tactical option be available.

The need for a standardized tactical option is more important today than ever before. This organization must be well trained, well equipped, highly motivated and able to conduct a variety of tasks in various environments at a moments notice.

The SRO must also be able to operate within many different environments. These include rural and urban areas in all types of weather and terrain. The SRO must also provide a response package that can react with the ability to hold and await further assistance from other supporting elements (mutual aid) or resolve the current situation if the need arises.

The Special Response Organization (SRO) must be able to respond to a wide range of high-risk incidents and be able to provide skilled and competent operators for various specialized tasks. These can include but are not limited to:

- Hostage Rescue
- High Risk Searches
- Barricade Incidents
- Active Threat/Shooter Incidents
- Counter-Terrorism (CT)
- Anti-Terrorism (AT)
- Maritime Counter Terrorism (MCT)
- Counter Drug
- Security of Key Installations
- Special Event Support/Management
- Protective Security Detail (PSD) Operations
- Disorder Management
- Search and Rescue

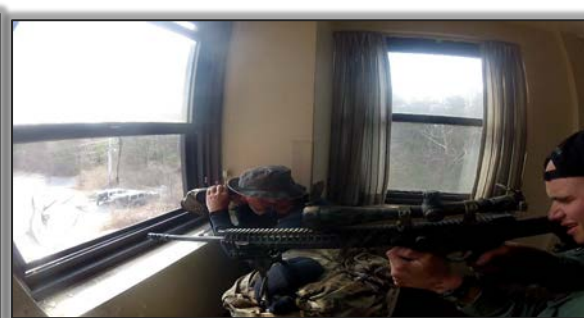




SRO-TAP Concept

The Special Response Organization Training and Advisory Program (SRO-TAP) evolution process is as follows:

- ① Organization Leadership/TATSOR Group Staff conduct a detailed Overview/Assessment of the Organization
- ② Organization Leadership/TATSOR Group Staff develop (3) year long/short/annual Training Plan to include initial Foundation Training Plan
- ③ TATSOR Group conducts identified initial Foundation Training Programs
- ④ TATSOR Group conducts monthly Sustainment Training w/Evaluations/Validations as required
- ⑤ TATSOR Group conducts Specialized Courses of Instruction (SCOI) as required
- ⑥ TATSOR Group conducts end of training year Evaluation/Validation Exercise
- ⑦ Organization Leadership/TATSOR Group Staff conduct end of training year Debrief/AAR and update the current (3) year Training Plan as required
