



COURSE: Executive Survival Program III (ESP-TIER III)
Hosted by the TATSOR Group and held at the Integrated Special Operations Training Facility (ISOTF), Altha Florida

DESCRIPTION: The Executive Survival Program (ESP III) is a specialized personal security/awareness and survivability program developed by the TATSOR Group and taught at the Integrated Special Operations Training Facility (ISOTF), Altha Florida.

The ESP is presented by elite professionals from within military and law enforcement special operations that possess extensive operational/personal security/survival experience internationally.

During the conduct of the ESP III each and every attendee's mind, body and spirit will be challenged through classroom presentation and kinetic skills applications within training modules that are designed to bring the attendee as close to the "real world" environment as is possible.

PURPOSE: To teach selected personnel the knowledge and skills required to identify evolving threats with emphasis upon avoiding and/or countering those threats in order to survive the high-risk encounter. The training will include but not be limited to:

- Introduction to the ESP III
- Introduction to the psychology of the high-risk encounter/high-risk threat event
- Introduction to the TATSOR Group Operator Mindset Program (OMP), a resilience program that provides instruction-practical application directed towards psychological and physiological countermeasures within the high-risk encounter/high-risk threat event
- Situational/tactical awareness-winning the fight before it begins
- Post crisis/event resilience training
- Securing the premises (home-apartment-hotel room-work/school space)
- Surveillance detection (foot-vehicle)
- Personal defense tactics-techniques-procedures (TTPs)
- Introduction to firearms
- Specialty weapons introduction/overview
- Marksmanship w/handgun and specialty weapons
- Defensive-offensive shooting tactics-techniques-procedures (TTPs)
- Executive survival clearing process (searches open air/confined spaces while armed)
- Fighting from a vehicle while armed
- Trauma medical applications
- Hostage survival
- High risk-encounter/high risk threat event scenarios



PRE-REQUISITES: Attendees are individuals/groups with a need and/or requirement for personal safety, security and personal protection skills at school; work-office; home; vacation; during travel.

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION: Class duration is 7 days (84+ hours). The program is limited to 20 attendees. Program cost on request and includes lodging and meals during the conduct of the program.
