COURSE: Advanced SWAT OPNS/Specialty Target Environment OPNS (ASO-STE0)
Hosted by the Cleveland TN Police Department and held at the Cleveland Police
Department Range Complex, Charleston TN/**16-20 July 2018**

PURPOSE:

To teach selected personnel the skills necessary to enable them to conduct Advanced Law Enforcement Special Operations versus specialized target platforms (Heavy Vehicles/Bus and Aircraft). The training will include but not be limited to:

- Introduction to ASO-STE0 operations (Vehicle/Aircraft Assault-Recovery)
- ASO-STE0 equipment
- ASO-STE0 tactics-techniques-procedures (TTP)
- ASO-STE0 marksmanship (MMS)
- ASO-STE0 CQB (Bus and Aircraft Assault-Recovery)
- TMOE (Bus and Aircraft)
- Operator Tactical Medical
- ASO-STE0 Psychology-Tactical Perspective
- Tactical law enforcement decision-making process (TLEDMP)

PRE-REQUISITES:

Member of a Law Enforcement, Corrections, Military or Security Organization with a requirement for ASO-STE0 skills-capabilities.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

To successfully complete the programs a student must be in **GOOD** physical and mental condition and progress through increasingly difficult training requirements.

The ASO-STE0 Program has numerous live fire exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded, must complete blocks of instruction. **This program is pending TN P.O.S.T. approval.**

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION:

Program duration is (5) Days/60+ hours and is limited to **24 personnel**. Course cost is **\$380.00** per attendee.
