

SPECIALTY TARGET ENVIRONMENT (STEO) OPERATIONS COURSE

COURSE: Specialty Target Environment Operations Course (Light-Medium-Heavy Vehicles) Presented by the TATSOR Group and held @ the ISOTF-Altha Florida 24-28 Sept 2018

PURPOSE: This course is designed for personnel identified with a requirement to plan for and conduct specialty target environment operations (STEO) versus light-medium-heavy wheeled conveyances /vehicles. The training will include but not be limited to:

- Introduction to STEO Operations (Light-Medium-Heavy Vehicle Assault-Recovery) STEO equipment
- > STEO Tactics-Techniques-Procedures versus Light-Medium-Heavy Vehicles
- STEO Marksmanship (MMS)
 STEO CQB TTPs (Confined
 Space) STEO TMOE/Breaching
- Operator Tactical Medical
- STEO Psychology-Tactical Perspective
- > Tactical Law Enforcement Decision-Making Process (TLEDMP)
- Dry-Live Fire Training/Scenarios

PREREQUISITES: Member of a Law Enforcement, Corrections, Military or Security Organization with a requirement for STEO skills-capabilities.

PROGRAM DURATION/SIZE/COST: Program duration is (5) Days/60+ hours and is limited to 24 personnel (minimum of 7 personnel to execute the program). Course cost is **\$625.00** per attendee and includes lodging on the facility.
