COURSE: Tactical Team (SWAT-LESO) Instructor Certification Program. Hosted by the Cleveland TN Police Department and held at the Cleveland Police Department Range Complex, Charleston TN/**29 Oct-2 Nov 2018**

PURPOSE:

To teach selected personnel the skills required to design, develop and present special operations training and sustainment. In classroom and out of classroom instruction will be addressed with emphasis upon training the trainer. The training will include but not be limited to:

- Introduction to the Special Operations Instructor
- TATSOR Group Training Management System (TMS)
- Training Development TTPs
- Tactical Safety-Risk Management and Mitigation
- Training Etiquette
- Tactical Physical Training (TPT) and Nutrition Development
- Program of Instruction (POI) Development and Construction
- Lesson Plan Development and Construction
- Tactical Marksmanship Instructor TTPs
- Close Quarters Battle (CQB) Instructor TTPs
- Classroom/Range/Shoot-House Presentation TTPs

PRE-REQUISITES:

The TTICP is designed to **train the trainer.** Attendees should be proficient regarding the instructional TTPs and systems within their respective agencies to include a rating as a firearms instructor. Attendees should also possess an ability to impart information to others and have a good working knowledge of teaching/instruction in general.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

The TTICP is performance-oriented training conducted in a low to high-risk environment. The TTICP has numerous live fire exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded, must complete blocks of instruction. The TTICP is **Missouri P.O.S.T approved (#1027) and is pending TN P.O.S.T. approval.**

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION:

Program duration is (5) Days/60+ hours and is limited to **<u>30 personnel</u>**. Course cost is **\$395.00** per attendee.
