



TACTICAL LEADERS COURSE

COURSE: Tactical Leaders Course (TLC)
3-7 June 2019 and held @ the ISOTF, Altha FI

PURPOSE: To teach selected personnel the skills required for leading, planning and successfully conducting tactical operations. The course will highlight the role of the leader within training and operationally as well as the planning process from call-out through post assault and stand-down. The training will include but not be limited to:

- Leadership within LE in the 21st century
- Leadership skills-traits-leadership in training/operationally
- SOP development
- Training-sustainment-evaluation of LE organizations
- Introduction to the tactical law enforcement decision making process (TLEDMP)
- The planning and assault process
- Warning order
- Operations order
- Mission concept/IPR brief back format
- Commander brief-back presentation system
- Holding area procedures
- Tactical intelligence and operations center operations (TIC-TOC)
- Contingency planning
- Crisis negotiation overview
- Command group, CNT and tactical element operational integration

PRE-REQUISITES: The TLC is designed to teach and further build upon the leadership and planning skills of the officer/tactical operator. Attendees should be members of an operational tactical or crisis/hostage negotiation team, key leaders/personnel with planning responsibilities or any personnel/agency requiring tactical planning for crisis situations. This program is also suited for LE Patrol and Corrections Officers seeking leadership and planning operations training/expertise.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: The TLC is performance-oriented training conducted in a low risk environment. To successfully complete the course a student must progress through increasingly difficult training requirements. Testing will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned. The TLC has numerous teaching exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded presentations. **This program is TN POST approved---#17-159**

NOTE: Attendance at the TLC does not mandate an attendee will graduate. Each attendee must meet and/or exceed course standards in order to receive a completion diploma. Those who do not will receive a certificate of attendance.

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/COST: Course is 5 days (42 hours). The course is limited to 36 personnel. Course cost is **\$450.00** per attendee.
