



OFFICER/OPERATOR TACTICAL MEDICAL COURSE (OTMC)

COURSE: Officer/Operator Tactical Medical Course (OTMC)
22-24 May 2019 and held @ the ISOTF, Altha FI

SCOPE: The OTM Course is designed to provide the Patrol-Corrections Officer and/or specialized tactical unit members with the skills necessary to provide immediate care and life support to injured personnel with additional emphasis upon self/buddy aid. Training will include classroom as well as hands on instruction culminating with realistic training scenarios. Students will receive classes on situation assessment, patient assessment in a tactical environment, rapid triage and management of multiple trauma patients, patient extraction and self/buddy aid TTPs.

The OTM-C is based upon the curriculum within the Assaulter Tactical Emergency Medicine Courses/ATEM I and II (Both ATEM Courses are Missouri POST approved).

PRE-REQUISITES: The OTM Course is designed to provide foundation training in the medical skill sets required by each and every first responder in order to save lives. Attendees should be law enforcement, corrections, security and/or military personnel with a requirement for tactical medical skills

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/TUITION: Program is 3 days (36+ hours) with a maximum class size of 30 personnel. Tuition is **\$400.00** per attendee and includes lodging on the facility if desired.
