



TACTICAL METHODS OF ENTRY BREACHING COURSE

COURSE: Tactical Methods of Entry Breaching Course (TMOEB)
15-17 April 2019 and held @ the ISOTF, Altha FI

PURPOSE: This course is designed for personnel with a requirement to conduct Tactical Methods of Entry Breaching (TMOEB) TTPs within the scope of Law Enforcement Operations and response to Active Assailants-Shooters. Training will include but is not limited to: MMS-tactical marksmanship with the handgun and patrol rifle in conjunction with breaching TTPs; Introduction to TMOEB equipment; Breaching essential elements of information (EEI); Tactical law enforcement planning (TLEDMP) as it relates to TMOEB; Light-medium-heavy mechanical breaching; Special purpose TMOEB. An integral part of the program curriculum also includes progression style TMOEB TTPs concentrating on actions at the point of entry and upon entry regarding TMOEB. The training will include the conduct of live fire TMOEB in conjunction with CQB in varied environments (normal, low light and reduced visibility).

PRE-REQUISITES: The TMOEB Course is performance-oriented training designed specifically for the Law Enforcement Officer. Attendees should be personnel with a TMOEB requirement. Each attendee must be proficient as per their respective departments patrol rifle qualification policy and have their respective weapon battle sight zeroed to them prior to attendance.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: The TMOEB Course is performance-oriented training conducted in a high-risk environment. To successfully complete the course a student must progress through increasingly difficult training. Testing will involve performance oriented "hands-on" application of the skills learned. The TMOEB Course has numerous live fire exercises, physical challenges, classroom lectures/conferences and graded presentations.

This program is pending TN P.O.S.T. approval.

CLASS SIZE/DURATION/TUITION: Maximum class size is 24. Duration is 3 days/36+ hours. Course cost is **\$400.00** per attendee and includes lodging on the Facility.
