



FIREARMS-MARKSMANSHIP INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM (FMICP)

COURSE: Firearms-Marksmanship Instructor Certification Program

Hosted by the Cleveland TN Police Department and held at the Cleveland Police Department HQ, Cleveland TN and CPD Range Complex, Charleston TN 2-6 December 2019

PURPOSE:

To teach selected personnel the skills required to design, develop and present firearms-marksmanship training and sustainment. In classroom and out of classroom instruction will be addressed with emphasis upon training the trainer. The training will include but not be limited to:

- Introduction to the Firearms-Marksmanship Instructor
- Instructor Training Management System (TMS)
- Training Development TTPs
- Tactical Safety-Risk Management and Mitigation
- Training Etiquette
- Program of Instruction (POI) Development and Construction
- Lesson Plan Development and Construction
- Tactical Marksmanship Instructor TTPs
- Foundation Firearms-Marksmanship Instructor TTPs
- Classroom/Range Presentation TTPs

PRE-REQUISITES:

The FMICP is designed to *train the trainer*. Attendees should be proficient regarding the instructional TTPs and systems within their respective agencies with a firearms-marksmanship foundation established. Attendees should also possess an ability to impart information to others and have a good working knowledge of teaching/instruction in general.

SPECIAL INFORMATION:

The FMICP is performance-oriented training conducted in a low to high-risk environment.

The FMICP has numerous live fire exercises, classroom lectures/conferences and graded, must complete blocks of instruction.

CLASS DURATION/SIZE/COST:

Program duration is (5) Days/58.5 hours and is limited to **30 personnel.** Cost per attendee is **\$305.00**.
