OVERVIEW:

The Tactical Endurance Challenge (TEC) is a dynamic, high energy event that challenges mind and body and is held at the FARM[™], Marianna Florida. The FARM[™] is a turnkey professional tactical training facility and the home to TATSOR[™] Group resident training programs/exercises.

The TEC is designed and based upon the assessment and selection programs utilized within special forces, special operations and counterterrorism units. The TEC is directed towards "the individual" and provides a self-competitive model...that is each participant competes against themselves.

During the conduct of the TEC each and every attendee's mind, body and spirit will be challenged through classroom presentation and kinetic skills applications in an "assess and select" environment.

The TEC is presented by elite professionals from within military and law enforcement special operations that possess extensive operational/training experience internationally. The TEC Cadre follow a variant of the same assessment and selection matrix that is utilized by the most elite special operations organizations to select not the very best personnel but **the right personnel**.

The TEC is limited to (50) attendees and will fill quickly.



REGISTRATION:

You must register individually at the TEC registration page on the TATSOR[™] Group website and be willing once contacted after registration to sign a non-disclosure agreement as well as fill out a personal information form. The form will contain health questions among others. During in processing on 10 November each attendee will undergo a screening process as well.

TEC DETAILS:

The TEC is a 70+/- hour event based upon the individual. No team events will be executed during the TEC. The majority of the TEC will include conducting movements over varied terrain and distances carrying a designated load/weight in a backpack-rucksack. Attendees will, in addition, participate in classroom presentations regarding key TEC knowledge areas as well as participate within physical training modules.

TEC attendees will ultimately be classified within the following areas:

<u>DOR</u>: Drop on Request (the attendee personally withdraws from TEC participation). Those who DOR do not receive any type of participation or completion certificate.

<u>MED DROP</u>: Attendee is withdrawn from the TEC based upon an injury or medical condition, which the Lead Medic determines, will not allow the attendee to continue without further injury/harm. Those who are MED Drops do not receive any type of participation or completion certificate.

<u>Complete Non-Selectee</u>: Attendee completes and passes through each phase and gate of the TEC and is a non-selectee based upon performance either during TEC conduct or at the Phase 6 TEC Board. A non-selectee will receive a certificate of attendance for the TEC.

<u>Complete/Selectee</u>: Attendee completes and passes through each phase and gate of the TEC and is a selectee based upon performance either during TEC conduct or at the Phase 6 TEC Board. A selectee will receive a certificate of completion for the TEC as well as a TEC "Selectee" T-shirt and TEC medallion.



PRE-REQUISITES:

The TEC is open to all genders age 18 and older that pass the initial screening process after registration and the final screening on 10 November during onsite in processing.

Special/Unique Items

- Any required life-saving medication (must be declared on your personal information form)
- Oral Rehydration Solution/Salts (ORS). Candidates are required to bring a minimum of four ORS packages manufactured by either AGS Brand, Drip Drop, or Jianas Brothers
- Small camping tent or like setup
- Sleeping bag
- Ponchos (2)
- Poncho liner (1)

TEC Event Specific Items

- Shovel (1)
- Beach towel (1)
- Pillow case (1)

Prohibited Items

- Watch
- GPS/Pedometer
- Map
- Energy supplements
- Medicine, unless potentially <u>lifesaving</u>
- Knives
- Sunglasses
- Any metal jewelry of any kind
- Any necklace of any kind
- Alcohol
- Morale patches
- Firearms or weapons of any kind
- Soft drinks-energy drinks-supplement drinks



MEALS/LODGING:

Meals

The TATSOR[™] Group will provide all foodstuffs, water, Gatorade powder, etc during the conduct of the TEC. Each attendee during in processing on November 10 will be issued (2) cases of a variant of meals ready to eat (MRE) and powdered Gatorade. In addition clean potable water will be on hand at all times. During the actual TEC events water and a Gatorade/water mix will always be on hand.

Lodging

Attendees will arrive with a small camping tent (1-2 person) or like setup and will be assigned a location to lodge for the duration of the program. Bathrooms (portable potties) will be provided and during the conduct of the TEC all personal hygiene will take place in a field type environment (upon completion of the TEC shower areas will be provided for attendees after the final debrief/out-processing and prior to departure).

COST/REFUND PROCESS:

Cost per TEC attendee is **\$300.00** and would be due as a part of the registration process via Debit/ Credit Card (payment process details can be found at the registration page). Registration and payment must be completed by 1 March 2021 to receive the **\$300.00** price. Registrations after 1 March 2021 will cost **\$350.00**. Registration closes 1 April 2021.

Refunds will be on a case-by-case basis only. No refunds of monies will take place after 1 April 2021 except in extreme situations.
